Coxs River Road Upgrade

Transport for NSW acknowledges people of the Wiradjuri Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Coxs River Road upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all local and highway road users, commuters and pedestrians.

The opening of the new Coxs River Road Bridge will occur on **30 May 2024** and is a major milestone for the Coxs River Road Upgrade.

Transport for NSW's lead contractor, Ertech is continuing works at Little Hartley for the Coxs River Road Upgrade.

What work are we doing?

We will be undertaking some nightworks to help prepare for the opening of the new bridge. These works will include:

- line marking
- installing signage
- removing and replacing barriers.
- tying in bridge approach roads to Coxs River Road and the Great Western Highway.

When and where we'll be working

We will continue working under our standard working hours between **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday.**

In addition, we will complete nightworks between **7pm and 5am**, on **29 May**.

If we need to work outside of these hours, we will notify you in advance.

What will this mean for you?

Most of this work will have minimal impact on residents. However, you will notice:

- noise from machinery and equipment
- plant movement in and out of the project site
- traffic control and reduced speed limits in place. Please allow an additional five minutes for your travel time.

The way you use Coxs River Road will change with the opening of the new bridge.

The map over the page outlines the changes and signage will be placed to assist road users.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- fencing work areas for safety and security
- using watercarts daily to help control dust
- reducing our noise as much as possible by working in stages and turning off machinery when not in use.

From 30 May, traffic will use the new Coxs River Road Bridge to access the existing Great Western Highway and adjacent residents will use the new access road.

All road users are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control and slow down on approach.
