

Traffic diversion at Little Hartley from 14 February

The Coxs River Road upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all local and highway road users, commuters and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW's lead contractor, Ertech, is carrying out the works at Little Hartley for the Coxs River Road Upgrade.

What work are we doing?

As part of the previously notified nightworks, **on Wednesday 14 February** we will temporarily divert both lanes of highway traffic from the Great Western Highway to a realigned section of the existing Great Western Highway near the Hartley Fresh café. This diversion will allow work to proceed on the construction of the new Highway.

- **Eastbound traffic** will move onto the service road near the Hartley Fresh café and back onto the existing highway near Mead's farm.
- **Westbound traffic** will move onto the service road near Mead's Farm and back onto the existing highway near Hartley Fresh café.
- **Baaners Lane access** will be via a link road across the closed existing highway to connect with the service road. Access at the service road will be the same configuration as used at the current Baaners Lane intersection with Great Western Highway.
- **Browns Gap access** will be directly onto the new service road.

This 600 metres of realigned highway used for the diversion will eventually become a local service road.

When and where we'll be working

We will switch the traffic on the night of Wednesday 14 February, weather permitting.

Working hours will be from **8pm to 5am**.

We will carry out this work at night, for the safety of workers and the least disturbance to highway traffic.

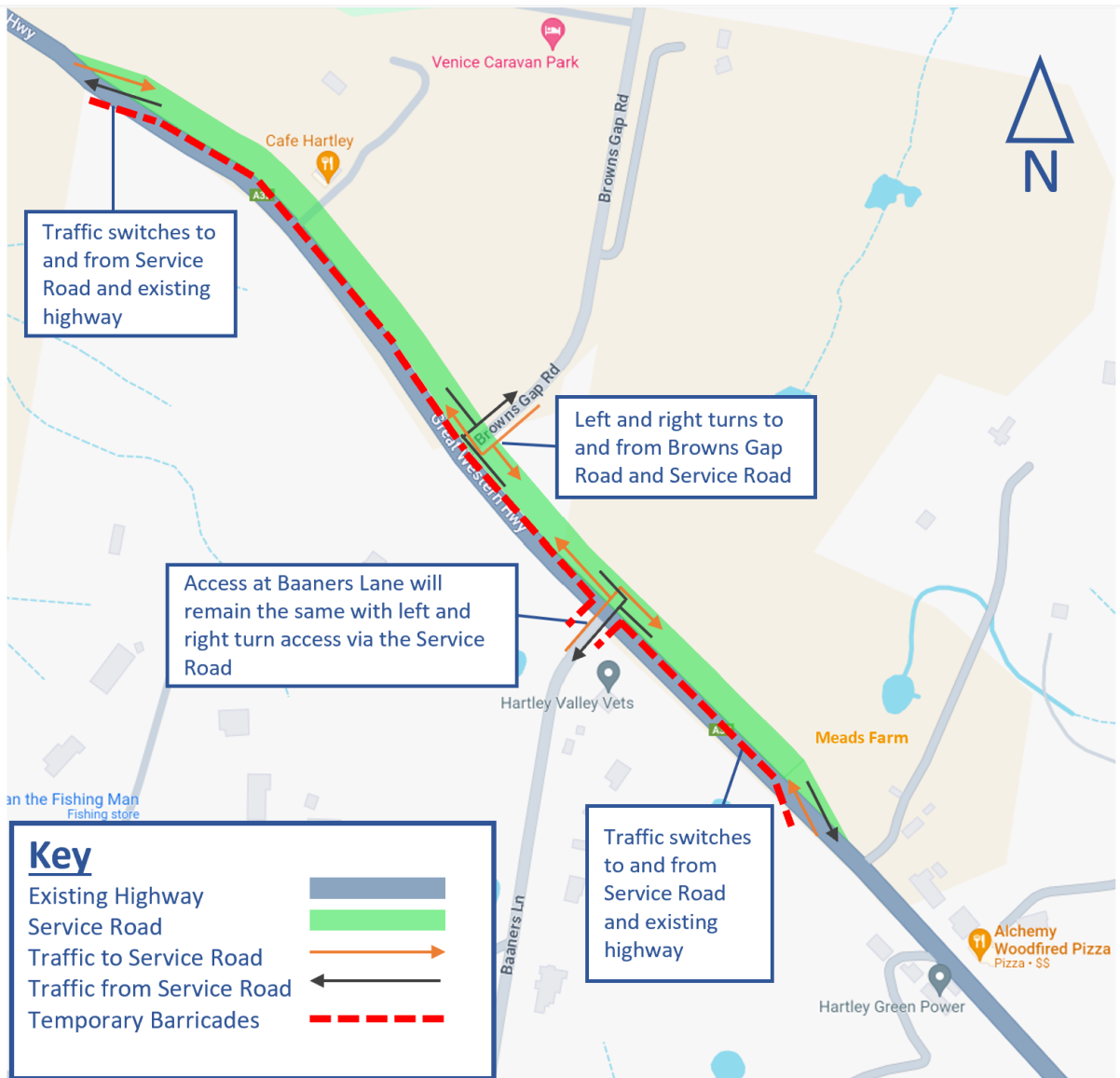
Pop-up Information Session
