

Dobroyd Parade Pedestrian Bridge

Geotechnical and utilities investigations

Transport for NSW is starting early investigation work for the Dobroyd Parade Pedestrian Bridge project to support detailed design.

Transport is undertaking geotechnical investigations and utilities investigations to better understand the ground conditions and location of underground utilities at the planned location of the pedestrian bridge at Dobroyd Parade at its intersection with Waratah Street, Haberfield.

What work are we doing?

This work includes:

- potholing and scanning and locating of utilities
- drilling four boreholes and one pavement core
- · digging one test pit.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working on Dobroyd Parade, Haberfield at the intersection of Waratah Street for **up to eight days and eight nights** between **Tuesday 16 April to Tuesday 21 May 2024**, weather permitting. Standard work hours are:

Monday to Friday - 7am to 6pm

Saturday - 8am to 1pm.

To minimise disruption and for the safety of our workers and road users, some nightwork will take place between:

Sunday to Thursday - 8pm to 5am.

No work will be undertaken on Saturdays and public holidays.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
 - · traffic controllers and signage
- lane closures and reduced speed limits
- footpath closures and pedestrian detours
- lights and noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

There will be some noise associated with the work and every effort will be made to minimise this impact including completing noisy work by midnight.

Traffic Changes

There may be lane closures and reduced speed limits. A variable message sign will be installed to notify road users of the change in traffic conditions. Traffic controllers will be on site to assist motorists, pedestrians, and cyclists with the temporary changes.
