What work are we doing?

Work has begun to upgrade the existing traffic signals at the Soldiers Parade and Henderson Road intersection to include new pedestrian crossings. All work is subject to weather and approvals.

Upcoming work includes:

- Installing cabling and poles for new traffic lights
- Removing existing and restoring road surface
- Installing new footpaths
- Programming for the new traffic signals
- Revised line marking and signage to suit the new intersection layout
- Landscaping work around the site
- General construction and finishing work.

Upcoming night work

As part of the traffic signal upgrade at the intersection of Soldiers Parade and Henderson Road, night work will be required to minimise disruption to daytime traffic and reduce safety risks to pedestrians, motorists and our workers.

The work includes relocating existing traffic signals at the intersection, installing new safety barrier along Soldiers Parade and programming traffic signals.

Subject to weather and approvals, night work is scheduled for the following dates:

- From 8pm to 5am for two nights on Monday 29
 January and Tuesday 30 January
- From 8pm to 5am for two nights on Monday 5
 February and 6 February

- From 8pm to 5am for two nights on Monday 12
 February and Tuesday 13 February
- From 8pm to 5am for three nights on Monday
 19 February, Tuesday 20 February and
 Wednesday 21 February.

If there are unforeseen delays, further work will be carried out from **8pm** to **5am** for two nights on **Monday 26 February** and **Tuesday 27 February**,

Workers will be on site from 6pm each night to set up.

Noisy work is anticipated at times during initial demolition activities. Wherever possible, measures to reduce noise will include starting noisiest work earlier in the night, turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, monitoring noise, using non-tonal reversing beepers and noise reduction blankets.

Traffic impacts

There will be temporary traffic impacts while we complete this work. This includes minor traffic flow changes, a reduced speed limit of 40km/h and traffic control.

While we complete this work, you may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signage
- lane changes and reduced speed limit
- noise from machinery and equipment

Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working within the site compound off Soldiers Parade, Edmondson Park and along Soldiers Parade and the intersection with Henderson Road.

Equipment to be used may include excavators, rollers, rock breakers, road saws, tipping trucks,

concrete mixers, service vehicles, various delivery vehicles, mobile cranes, forklifts, generators and hand tools.

Standard work hours are **7am** to **6pm**, **Monday** to **Friday** and **8am** to **1pm**, **Saturday**.
