Transport for NSW will continue works to improve safety on Garfield Road East near Edmund Street, Riverstone.

Due to delays caused by recent wet weather, works are expected to take place for approximately another four weeks until **Saturday 31 August**

We will undertake line marking, signage installation, finishing work and landscaping.

Crews will work up to five nights a week between **8pm and 5am, excluding Saturday and Sunday nights**, unless otherwise notified. We expect up to a total of 10 night shifts will be required for this work. Day work will occur between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturdays**. There will be no work on public holidays. We expect up to a total of 20 day shifts will be required for this work.

To reduce the effects of this work, we will monitor noise periodically and adjust our work as required. In addition, we will also:
