

Continuation of work - Pedestrian safety improvements on Garfield Road East near Hamilton Street

Transport for NSW acknowledges Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is upgrading Sydney's road network, easing congestion, improving traffic flow, reducing travel times and making the roads safer.

Transport for NSW will continue works to improve safety on Garfield Road East near Hamilton Street, Riverstone until **Saturday 31 August**.

The improvements include:

- a pedestrian refuge on Garfield Road East
- new pram ramps on Garfield Road East providing access to the pedestrian refuge
- installation of a footpath with a pedestrian fence on the northern side of Garfield Road East into Hamilton Street
- placement of bollards on the northern side of Garfield Road East extending past the Riverstone Sports Centre.

Due to further delays caused by wet weather, work is expected to take place for approximately another four weeks, weather permitting.

Our work schedule

Crews will work up to five nights a week between **8pm** and **5am**, excluding Saturday and Sunday nights, unless otherwise notified. We expect up to a total of 10 night shifts will be required for this work.

Day work will occur between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturdays. There will be no work on public holidays. We

expect up to a total of 20 shifts will be required for this work.

How will the work affect you?

Temporary traffic changes, such as short-term lane closures and speed reductions, may be implemented to maintain safety for road workers, motorists, and pedestrians within the work zone.

Please keep to the speed limits and obey the instructions provided by traffic controllers and road signs. Barriers and traffic cones will be positioned to mark work areas. Motorists should anticipate minor delays due to altered traffic conditions.

Benefits

The planned improvements aim to:

- provide convenient and safe crossing facilities for people with limited mobility such as wheelchair users, parents and caregivers with prams
- promote a more efficient flow of traffic, reducing delays and congestion for all road users
- prevent unsafe informal vehicle access onto Garfield Road East from Orlagh Crescent.

- landscaping
- finishing works
