


Transport Access Program Dapto Station Upgrade

Community notification

February - March 2024





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is upgrading accessibility at Dapto Station. This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, aiming to provide a station precinct that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Upcoming work

Upgrades to the level crossing at Dapto Station will continue in February and March.

We will be installing VeloSTRAIL, a hard-wearing rubber product eliminating the gap between rail and pedestrian surfaces, at the level crossing.

Other work includes:

- excavating
- installing new cable routes, mechanical and emergency gates
- pouring new concrete footpaths and asphalt
- line marking and installing tactiles.

Out-of-hours work

Out-of-hours work will be carried out between 6pm Friday 23 February and 7am Monday 26 February.

For the safety of staff and passengers, this work will take place during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period when no trains are running, and the station is closed.

Respite vouchers may be offered to residents immediately surrounding the work areas.

Wherever possible, we will take measures to reduce noise, including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, exercising respite periods during work and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Equipment being used includes excavators and delivery trucks, concrete pump and trucks, dump trucks, lighting towers and hand tools.

Temporary traffic impacts

We will temporarily be partially closing Bong Bong Road between Station Street and Hamilton Street, from **7pm Friday 23 February to 4am Saturday 24 February**. Traffic in both directions will be maintained.

A full road closure will also occur between 4am Saturday 24 February and 4am Monday 26 February. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained.

Traffic control and detours will be in place and pedestrian access will be maintained.

Working hours

Normal working hours are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturdays**.

All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.
