What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance work at Hawkesbury River Bridge substation from Monday 22 July to Friday 30 August to ensure reliability of electrical services.

We will be utilising the wharf access road off Dangar Road at Hawkesbury River Station for access and egress of machinery, vehicles, and workers to the worksite. This will result in increased volume of traffic on the wharf access road.

We understand this work will have an impact on you and your neighbours and appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise over the weekend and at night.
- Works will take place from 7am to 5pm Monday 22 July to Friday 30 August.
- Weekend work will take place from 5am Saturday 3 August to 7pm Sunday 4 August.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic

- Heavy vehicles and machinery will use local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that parking will be limited near worksite.
