
Traffic lane shifting along Heathcote Road

Heathcote Road Upgrade

November 2024







Transport for NSW acknowledges the Cabrogal people of the Darug Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Work is continuing to advance on the Heathcote Road Upgrade between Infantry Parade, Holsworthy and The Avenue, Voyager Point. This will help reduce congestion, improve road safety and provide more reliable journeys for all road users.

Traffic lane shifting

We will be continuing to conduct several traffic lane shifts across the Heathcote Road Upgrade until the end of the year. Traffic lane shifts are when we transition traffic onto new sections of road we have recently built. There will be several changes in traffic conditions as we shift traffic lanes along Heathcote Road.

When we will be working

We will work for about eight nights between 15 November and 20 December 2024, weather permitting, between the hours of 8pm to 5am at:

- Heathcote Road near The Avenue
- Heathcote Road at the MacArthur Drive Roundabout
- Heathcote Road between Alec Campbell Drive and The Avenue

In addition to the nightworks, construction will also occur on certain weekends at the intersections. Partial lane closures and traffic control will be in place for the safety of workers and road users during pavement construction and the traffic lane shift.

What this will mean for you?

Night and weekend work is required to minimise traffic disruptions and reduce safety risks to workers and road users.

The work may be noisy at times. However, we will make every effort to minimise the impact for residents by carrying out noisier work before midnight where possible.

During night and weekend work we may use noisy machinery and equipment including:

- generators/lighting towers
- excavators
- street sweepers
- concrete trucks and pumps
- powered hand tools
- asphalt profiler and roller

What we are excited about

- Improved traffic flow: The shifts will help optimise traffic movement along Heathcote Road and allow construction in key areas needed for the upgrade.
- Enhanced safety: Moving traffic onto newly constructed sections improves road safety for both drivers and workers.
- Progress milestones: Each shift marks a significant step forward in the project, bringing us closer to completion.
- Upgraded infrastructure: New lanes, bridges at Williams Creek and Harris Creeks, and road surfaces mean a smoother and more reliable route for all road users.
