

More Trains, More Services

February 2024

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Bidjigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

We are upgrading the rail infrastructure near Hurstville Station to allow trains to cross over from one track to another. This will mean that local services travelling away from the city can end their journey at Hurstville Station on Platform 4 and then start their return service to the city from Platform 3.

What work are we doing?

Between late 2020 and mid-2022, we installed new track and signalling infrastructure inside the rail corridor.

In February 2024, we will prepare this infrastructure for operational use. We will also remove a redundant track crossover (a piece of rail infrastructure that allows trains to change tracks) and replace it with straight tracks.

When and where we'll be working

Standard construction hours are between **7am** and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.

For safety reasons, some work will take place outside of these hours between **10pm Friday 9 February to 2am Monday 12 February 2024** when no trains will be running.

Work will take place inside the rail corridor as shown on the map overleaf. The compounds on Forest Road and Woniora Road will be used for deliveries, storage of materials and equipment, worker briefings and parking.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- traffic control on Forest Road to manage vehicles accessing the compound
- lighting from temporary lighting towers
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We understand our work may cause disruption for the community. We'll seek to minimise impacts as much as possible and follow strict environmental conditions relating to light spill, noise, vibration and dust management.

There's a lot happening

There are multiple contractors working within the Hurstville rail corridor.
