Jannali Platform 2 Reconstruction

From Saturday 6 July to Monday 8 July 2024

What we're doing

Platform 2 at Jannali was constructed between the 1920s and 1930s and has reached the end of its life. Sydney Trains is upgrading the platform foundation and surface while preserving the newly built station structure and utilities. This re-build will meet all relevant modern standard requirements and extend the platform by 16 metres.

Sydney Trains will undertake reconstruction works at Jannali Platform 2 from Saturday 6 July to Monday 8 July. The reconstruction of the platform will take multiple weekends in 2024 and 2025.

Work activities will include:

- Reconstruction of approximately 60m of Platform 2 in each possession
- Removal of existing vertical post and horizontal planks
- Preparation of foundation for the culvert units
- Installation of culvert units
- Installation of precast cantilever top slab/coping
- Installation of temporary tactiles

We understand this work will have an impact on you and your neighbours. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Platform 2

- Platform 2 will be ready for train operation on Monday morning.
- There will be no impact on commuters when accessing the platform.
- The newly constructed area will be noticeable and there will be a slight transition from the existing surface level to the new platform.

Noise

- These works may create additional noise over the weekend.
- **Work will take place from 3am Saturday 6 July to 2am Monday 8 July.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to day time travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor wherever possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near the worksite.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians throughout the duration of the works.
