


Utility work on King Street between George Street and Pitt Street

King Street Cycleway

October 2024





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The King Street Cycleway will provide a missing cycleway link on King Street between Clarence Street and Pitt Street.

About the King Street Cycleway

The project involves extending the existing separated cycleway between Clarence Street and Pitt Street. Providing this important missing link will improve the connectivity of bike networks in Sydney CBD.

Upcoming utility work

Before main construction work of the cycleway starts, we need to relocate telecommunications utilities on King Street, between George Street and Pitt Street.

This work will involve localised saw cutting, drilling, and jack hammering while we trench. You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signage
- lane closures and reduced speed limits
- · temporary footpath closures and detours
- noise from machinery and equipment.


When we'll be working

Our work needs to be carried out at night to limit disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers, pedestrians and motorists.

We will work for approximately **36 night shifts**, up to 5 nights a week between **Monday 21 October** and **Friday 20 December**, weather permitting.

Our work hours are between **8pm and 5am** from **Sunday to Thursday.**

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. This site compound is designed to minimise impact.

This includes:

- fencing for safety and security
- reducing our noise as much as possible and using noise curtains, where possible
- targeted lighting to minimise light spill.

Traffic and pedestrian diversions will be in place at times. Traffic controllers will be on site to direct motorists and pedestrians. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signage.
