The NSW Government is improving accessibility and safety at Lewisham Station

This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Safe Accessible Transport program. The program aims to make public transport safer, more inclusive and easier to use for all passengers.

Improvements will be designed to support our diverse customers, such as people with disabilities, parents or carers with prams, the elderly, and women and girls.

Project status

We have developed a draft concept design by looking at the site's unique opportunities and constraints, and through undertaking targeted stakeholder engagement.

We are now seeking community feedback on this design. The feedback we receive will influence the final concept design.

A Review of Environmental Factors (REF) will then be prepared using the design.

Engagement with the community and key stakeholders will be ongoing throughout project development and delivery.

What we have heard so far


So far, we have engaged with various groups including Inner West Council, people with disability, and separately with women and girls from the local community through a Safer Cities Program workshop.

We also accessed existing customer feedback about Lewisham Station to help understand community sentiment.

These engagements and research provided insights into how the transport network is used and the opportunities we have to improve passengers' experiences.

Feedback we have heard so far includes:

- Flooding in the underpass needs to be addressed.
- Safety and security: additional safety measures such as CCTV, help points and mirrors, wayfinding signage and additional lighting will help the station feel safer. Railway Terrace bus stop and Thomas Street can feel unsafe at times.
- Accessibility: include a lift lobby with space for someone in a wheelchair to safely wait while passengers alight the lift, make sure street furniture (ie seats, bicycle hoops) don't block paths for people with vision impairment, and use larger lift buttons.
- Suggestions to include a ramp to access station platforms instead of, or as well as, the new lifts.

Safe Accessible Transport program

This project is being delivered as part of the Safe Accessible Transport program, which aims to make public transport safe, inclusive and easy to use for all passengers, especially people with disability, older people, people with prams or luggage and others who may be experiencing mobility problems.

The program will upgrade stations to achieve Disability Standards for Accessible Public Transport (DSAPT) compliance, improving amenity, access and safety and acknowledging the important role these locations have to the communities they serve.
