


Out of hours work for the installation of temporary roundabout in Kemps Creek

M12 Motorway

January 2024







Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The Australian and NSW governments are building the M12 Motorway to provide direct access to the Western Sydney International Airport at Badgerys Creek and connect to Sydney's motorway network.

What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW will continue night work for the installation of a temporary roundabout at the intersection of Elizabeth Drive and Devonshire Road in Kemps Creek up to **Thursday 15 February** 2024

During this period, we will:

- · resurface the road
- carry out line marking
- restore the area when all pavement and other work is complete.

When and where we'll be working

Heavy rainfall during January means we will now continue work at the intersection of Elizabeth Drive and Devonshire Road between **8pm** and **5am**, **Sunday to Thursday** up to **Thursday 15 February 2024**. No work will take place on Friday and Saturday night or public holidays.

This work needs to be carried out at night for the safety of our workers and road users and to minimise traffic disruption. We apologise for this work continuing past the end of January due to poor weather.

We will continue to move vehicles and materials to and from the construction compound at the northern end of Salisbury Avenue between **8pm** to **5am**, **Sunday** to **Thursday** and **7am** to **5pm**, **Monday** to **Friday**.

What equipment will be used?

We may use excavators, light and heavy vehicles, hand power tools, hand compaction tools, water carts, asphalt pavers, skid steer sweepers and lighting towers.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles in the area
- traffic controllers and signage
- lane closures and reduced speed limits
- up to two overnight closures of Devonshire Road to through traffic
- pedestrian and cyclist detours with traffic controllers on site to guide you
- noise from plant and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- carrying out high impact work before midnight where possible
- turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use




- ensuring access to Salisbury Avenue is adequately maintained
- targeted lighting to minimise light spill
- monitoring noise so we can manage any potential impacts and adjust our work where possible.
- We apologise for this work continuing into February due to poor weather.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes along the work zone during our work hours to ensure this area and traffic are safe.

People turning right into Salisbury Avenue off Elizabeth Drive should do so via Devonshire Road, Cross Street and Western Road.

The intersection of Elizabeth Drive and Devonshire Road began to operate as a roundabout from 7 December 2023.
