



# Drainage upgrade work at Eveleigh

## More Trains, More Services

February 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

We are upgrading the rail infrastructure between Sydney Terminal and Erskineville Junction to support the introduction of the new fleet of trains operating on the South Coast Line. This includes upgrading the drainage system within the rail corridor at Eveleigh to prevent future flooding and improve reliability across the network.

### What work are we doing?

Work to upgrade the drainage system inside the rail corridor at Eveleigh is nearing completion. We are planning to carry out final adjustments and inspections in February 2024.

During this time we will also work on existing infrastructure inside the rail corridor near Redfern Station. This will involve the removal of weeds to allow the team to access the infrastructure.

The site compound shown on the map overleaf will be used for deliveries, storage of materials and equipment, and worker parking.

### When we'll be working

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.**

For safety reasons, some work will take place outside of these hours **10pm Friday 2 February to 2am Monday 5 February 2024.**

This work will take place during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period when no trains are running.

### What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- noise from machinery and equipment
- lighting from temporary lighting towers.

### Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption for the community. We'll seek to minimise impacts as much as possible and adhere to strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.

### Other work in your area

As outlined in a previous notification, More Trains, More Services will also use the site compound for worker parking on the following dates:

- **Friday 26 January to Monday 29 January 2024**
- **Friday 9 February to Monday 12 February 2024**
- **Friday 1 March to Monday 4 March 2024.**

Additionally, there are multiple other transport agencies and contractors working within the rail corridor and site compound.
