



Sydney West Overhead Wiring Upgrade – Guildford

More Trains, More Services

January 2024

The More Trains, More Services program will simplify and modernise the rail network creating high capacity, turn up and go services for many customers. It means customers can expect more frequent train services, with less wait times, less crowding on a simpler and more reliable network.

This project will upgrade overhead wiring infrastructure inside the rail corridor to improve train movements through Guildford Station.

What work are we doing?

In January 2024 we will work on existing cables and install new overhead wiring structures inside the rail corridor.

When we'll be working

Standard construction hours are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays**.

Some work is required to take place outside of standard construction hours from **10pm Friday 26 January to 2am Monday 29 January 2024**.

This work will take place during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period when no trains will be running. Scheduling construction work outside of standard construction hours enables our project team to complete the activities safely.

Temporary parking removal

From **5am Thursday 25 January to 2am Monday 29 January 2024** there will be a temporary loss of **up to 25 parking spaces in the commuter carpark on Military Road** (between Grove Street and Guildford Road). This is to facilitate deliveries and construction activities, including the setup of a crane to lift machinery and equipment onto the railway tracks.

What will this mean for you?

In addition to the temporary removal of parking along Military Road, you may notice:

- an increase in workers and vehicles
- noise from machinery and equipment
- lighting from temporary lighting towers
- traffic control on Military Road.

Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption for the community. We will seek to minimise impacts as much as possible and adhere to strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.
