



# Sydney West Overhead Wiring Upgrade

## More Trains, More Services

April and May 2024



Transport for NSW pays respect to Elders past and present, and recognises and celebrates the diversity of Aboriginal peoples and their ongoing cultures and connections to the lands and waters of NSW.

### The More Trains, More Services program is designed to simplify and modernise the rail network.

Passengers will be able to access more services on a simpler and more reliable network through the delivery of better infrastructure, new trains and extra services.

This project will upgrade infrastructure inside the rail corridor to improve train movements through Seven Hills, Toongabbie, Pendle Hill, Wentworthville and Westmead stations.

### What work are we doing?

In April and May 2024 we will work on existing overhead wiring structures inside the rail corridor. Our work will also involve site investigations (at Westmead only) in the form of borehole drilling to determine ground conditions.

### Where we'll be working

Work will take place inside the rail corridor as shown on the map overleaf.

We will use temporary laydown areas along the rail corridor for deliveries, storage of materials and equipment, worker briefings and parking.

### When we'll be working

Standard construction hours are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am and 1pm on Saturdays**.

Some work and deliveries will take place outside these hours from:

- **5am Tuesday 23 April to 6pm Friday 26 April 2024** (*Deliveries and site setup only*)
- **6pm Friday 26 April to 2am Monday 29 April 2024**
- **10pm Friday 17 May to 2am Monday 20 May 2024.**

This work will take place during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains will be running, enabling our team to complete essential activities safely.

### Temporary parking restrictions

Some on-street and commuter parking will be temporarily reserved for construction vehicles and machinery to facilitate work inside the rail corridor.

We will install signage to indicate when and where the parking restrictions will be in effect.

### What will this mean for you?

In addition to temporary parking restrictions, you may notice:

- noise from machinery and equipment
- traffic control
- an increase in workers and vehicles
- lighting from temporary lighting towers.
