Zero Emission Buses Program

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wallumattagal people of the Dharug Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW (Transport) is proposing to build a new bus depot at Macquarie Park as part of the Zero Emission Buses Program.

The new bus depot will be located at 1A and 1B Talavera Road, Macquarie Park. When complete, the depot will operate battery electric buses, reducing operational impacts on our neighbours and delivering quieter streets, cleaner air and greener operations.

What work are we doing?

As part of the planning process, we are assessing the site's underground conditions. This is called geotechnical investigation and it will be undertaken in March.

Work includes:

- establishing a temporary site compound
- surveying utilities in the area
- borehole drilling at approximately 13 locations
- demobilising the site compound after work is complete.

Equipment used includes:

- light vehicles
- trucks
- drilling equipment and machinery.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working at 1A Talavera Road Macquarie Park over one weekend from **Friday 1 March 2024**.

Working hours are **7am to 5pm, Friday to Sunday**.

What will this mean for you?

During our work, you may notice noise from machinery and equipment, and workers and vehicles near the site.

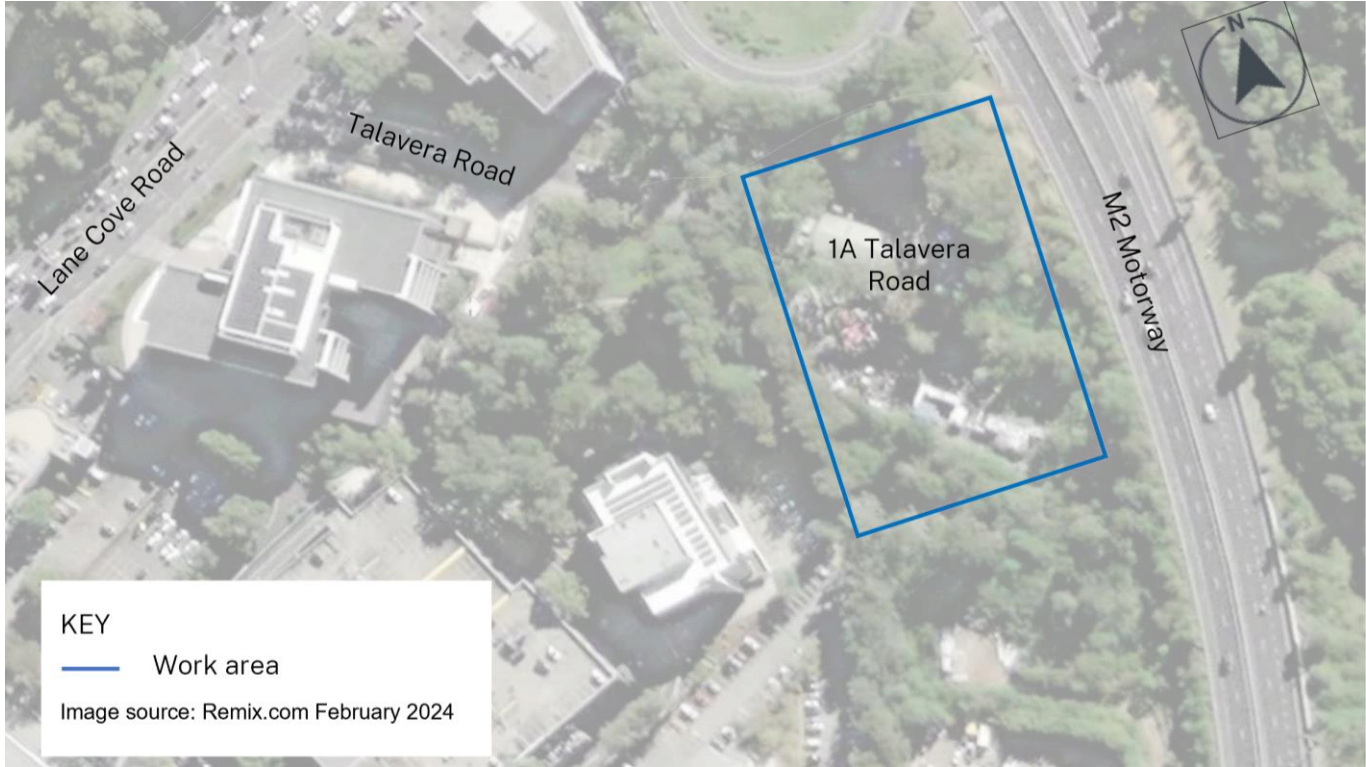
We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. No traffic changes or detours will be in place for this work.

What is the Zero Emission Buses Program?

Transport's Zero Emission Buses Program is a multi billion dollar program to transition the states 8,000 plus diesel and compressed natural gas public transport buses to zero emission technology by 2047.

The first stage of the transition is underway with 11 existing bus depots being converted to support the new battery electric fleet and a new battery electric bus depot being built at Macquarie Park.

There are many benefits from transitioning to zero emission buses, including:

- a smoother bus ride experience and more comfort for passengers
- quieter streets and local areas
- cleaner air with no bus exhaust fumes.
