

Macquarie Park Precinct and Bus Interchange Footpath investigation work

September 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wallumedegal people of the Dharug Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work.

The Australian Government and NSW Government are investing nearly \$200 million to improve transport in Macquarie Park to create a vibrant green 'heart' for the precinct.

Transport for NSW will carry out utilities investigation work on Waterloo Road near the corner of Herring Road.

These investigations will identify and confirm the location and depth of utilities, which will inform further planning and design of the Macquarie Park Precinct and Bus Interchange project.

What work are we doing?

Work will include detailed utility investigation beneath the footpath.

Work includes:

- Establishing a temporary work site
- Saw cutting into the footpath to locate utilities below
- Restoring the footpath when investigations are finished.

When and where we'll be working

We will be onsite for three day and night shifts, between **Monday 16 September** and **Friday 20 September** weather permitting.

Our day work hours will be between **7am and 6pm** from **Monday to Friday** and from **8am and**

1pm on Saturday. Our night work hours will be between **8pm and 5am** from **Monday to Thursday.**

What will this mean for you?

Some of our investigation work will occur during the day. However, we will need to carry out most of this work at night to reduce the disruption to pedestrians and traffic and to ensure the safety of workers.

Our night work may be noisy at times. We will do everything we can to lessen the disturbance.

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. A lane closure and footpath detour will be in place, which may affect travel times.

Traffic controllers and signs will guide pedestrians and motorists through the area. Please keep to speed limits and follow directions.

How we'll reduce our effects

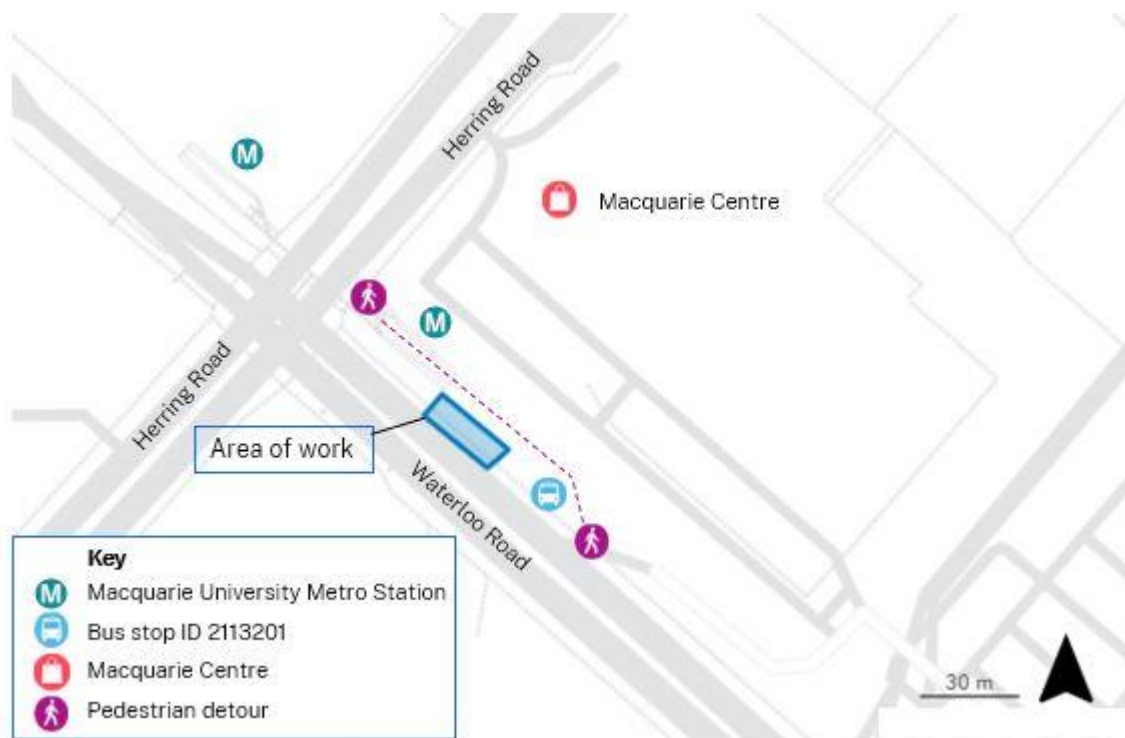
We will aim to limit the disruption on the community. This includes:

- Noisy activities will be completed by 11pm
- Pedestrian barriers will be in place for safety and security. Please note the detour on the map below
- Turning off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing alarms to reduce noise



- Scheduling breaks when carrying out high noise activities, such as saw cutting (one hour break after every three hours of continuous high noise work)
- Limit dust from our work by using water carts and hoses as required.
