



Construction work starting from Thursday 17 October

Mamre Road upgrade

October 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people of the Tharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Mamre Road between the M4 Motorway, St Clair and Erskine Park Road, Erskine Park to reduce congestion and improve safety and travel times.

Transport for NSW is upgrading 3.8 kilometres of Mamre Road between the M4 Motorway, St Clair and Erskine Park Road, Erskine Park.

Construction work will start from **Thursday 17 October**, weather permitting and is expected to be completed in 2027.

What work are we doing?

Our work activities will include:

- investigating, locating and marking where underground utility services are located
- relocating water, sewer, electricity, gas and telecommunications infrastructure
- installing fencing and site boundary flagging
- vegetation and tree clearing within work areas
- survey and site investigation work
- installing erosion and sediment controls
- installing temporary traffic control, signs and safety barriers
- importing and stockpiling material for construction work
- carrying out bulk earthworks
- constructing temporary and permanent pavements and access roads
- constructing water detention and filtration systems
- saw cutting and removing existing pavement, kerbs, and islands
- removing old and installing new line marking

- establishing site office buildings, storage and stockpile areas at 295 and 167-179 Mamre Road and 103-145 Mandalong Close.

When and where we'll be working

The work will take place along and next to Mamre Road, between the M4 Motorway, St Clair and Erskine Park Road, Erskine Park.

Our work hours will be between **7am and 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm, Saturday**.

Where possible, we will carry out work during the day, however, ongoing work outside of standard construction hours will be needed to maintain the safety for road users and workers, and to keep people moving during peak travel times.

From **Monday 28 October to Friday 29 November**, we will work three nights a week in various locations along Mamre Road. Our night shift hours will be between **6pm and 5am**. We will notify nearby residents directly.

There will be no work on public holidays.

What will this mean for you?

There may be some noise associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise impacts to nearby residents and businesses by arranging the work in stages at different locations and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

What equipment will we use?

During the work, we may use excavators, graders, rollers, bobcats, backhoes, mobile cranes, boring rigs, light and heavy vehicles, hand power tools, vacuum trucks, water carts, sweepers, road saws,



elevated working platforms, chainsaws, and generators.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes along Mamre Road during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
