


Early site set up work starting from Monday 9 September

Mamre Road upgrade

August 2024





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people of the Tharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Mamre Road between the M4 Motorway, St Clair and Erskine Park Road, Erskine Park to reduce congestion and improve safety and travel times.

Seymour Whyte Constructions has been awarded the construction contract to upgrade this section of Mamre Road.

We will begin work to set up the site compound and prepare other areas along Mamre Road from Monday 9 September. Work will take about three months to complete, weather permitting.

What work are we doing?

Our work activities will involve:

- installing temporary fencing, including site boundary flagging
- closing the road shoulder on both sides of Mamre Road south of Banks Drive
- survey and site investigation work
- ground investigations along the corridor
- installing erosion and sediment controls
- installing temporary traffic control, signs and safety barriers
- establishing site office buildings, storage and stock pile areas at 295 Mamre Road, St Clair and near Mandalong Close, Erskine Park
- removing minor vegetation around site office compounds and storage areas
- delivering concrete barriers to storage areas
- investigating, locating and marking where underground utility services are located.

When and where we'll be working

The work will take place along and next to Mamre Road, between the M4 Motorway, St Clair and Erskine Park Road, Erskine Park.

We will be onsite from **Monday 9 September** to **Saturday 30 November**, weather permitting.

Our work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm**, **Monday** to **Friday** and **8am** to **1pm**, **Saturday**.

There will be no work at night or on public holidays.

What will this mean for you?

There may be some noise associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise impacts to nearby residents and businesses by arranging the work in stages at different locations and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

What equipment will be used?

During the work, we may use excavators, graders, rollers, bobcats, backhoes, mobile cranes, boring rigs, light and heavy vehicles, hand power tools, vacuum trucks, water carts, sweepers and generators.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes along Mamre Road during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
