Mamre Road upgrade

December 2024

Transport for NSW is upgrading Mamre Road between the M4 Motorway, St Clair and Erskine Park Road, Erskine Park to reduce congestion and improve safety and travel times.

What work are we doing?

We will continue to work at night for up to **16 shifts** from **Tuesday 7 January** to **Friday 31 January** along Mamre Road between the M4 Motorway, St Clair and Erskine Park Road, Erskine Park.

Our work activities will include:

- installing safety barriers
- utility and stormwater installations, relocations and investigations
- removing trees and vegetation within work areas
- removing, repairing and installing road surfaces
- water trucks spraying to reduce dust on site
- delivering, using and removing equipment from work areas as needed
- road surface line marking.

Upcoming day work activities

Other work activities will continue during standard construction hours. You may see us on site:

- investigating, locating and marking where underground utility services are located
- relocating water, sewer, electricity, gas and telecommunications infrastructure
- survey and site investigation work

- importing and stockpiling material for construction work
- carrying out bulk earthwork
- constructing temporary and permanent road surfaces and access roads
- saw cutting and removing existing road surface, kerbs, and islands
- removing old and installing new line marking.

Our work schedule

Our night shift hours will be between **6pm** and **7am**, from **Monday night** to **Saturday** morning. We will not work more than two nights in a row and three nights in a week, in the same location. We will notify nearby residents directly.

Our normal work hours are between **7am** and **6pm**, **Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm**, **Saturday**.

There will be no work on Sundays or public holidays.

Where possible, we will carry out work during the day. Some work will need to be done outside of standard construction hours to maintain the safety of road users and workers, and to keep people moving during peak travel times.

What will this mean for you?

There may be some noise associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise impacts to nearby residents and businesses by arranging the work in stages at different locations and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.



What equipment will we use?

During the work, we may use excavators, graders, rollers, bobcats, backhoes, mobile cranes, boring rigs, light and heavy vehicles, hand power tools, vacuum trucks, water carts, sweepers, road saws, elevated working platforms, chainsaws, lighting towers, asphalt pavers, traffic barrier installation equipment, generators, welders and metal cutting equipment.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes along Mamre Road during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
