

Weekend Closure of Mandagery Creek Bridge at Manildra 19-22 January 2024

Mandagery Creek Bridge replacement project

January 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wiradjuri people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is funding the replacement of Mandagery Creek Bridge on the Henry Parkes Way at Manildra. The new \$12 million bridge will be stronger, safer and provide enhanced access for heavy vehicles and pedestrians.

When we'll be working

Work is well underway on the second stage of the Mandagery Creek Bridge replacement project.

To allow for essential construction works, up to **ten** full weekend closures of Mandagery Creek Bridge are required.

The third closure will be from **Friday 19 January to Monday 22 January 2024**.

During this closure, the bridge will be closed to all traffic from **6pm Friday to 6am Monday**.

This closure will allow for twelve pre-cast girders to be installed using a large mobile crane. Work will start on the Orange side of the creek on Friday evening, before the crane is moved to the Manildra side for the remaining work on Saturday and Sunday.

Please be aware that during the closure weekends there may be times where construction activity on site appears low – this is to allow for sufficient concrete curing to take place.

What will this mean for you?

Mandagery Creek Bridge will be closed in both directions with a detour via Cudal in place.

Weekend closures will continue to occur **non-consecutively throughout the remaining duration**

of the project, which is expected to be complete in mid-2024, weather permitting.

Dates of the planned weekend closures will be advertised at least two weeks in advance on roadside electronic signage and our website. Wet weather may result in a change of date at short notice.

There is currently no pedestrian access across Mandagery Creek due to the loss of the pedestrian bridge in the November 2022 flood event.

Lane width restriction on the bridge is currently 3m.

Detours and traffic impacts

A detour via Cudal will be in place for all vehicles needing to travel across Mandagery Creek Bridge, including Manildra residents needing to travel from one side of town to the other.

The detour will add about 30 minutes to trips for Manildra residents who need to travel across Mandagery Creek, as well as for motorists travelling to and from Manildra across the bridge.

The detour will add about 15 minutes to journeys between Parkes and Orange.

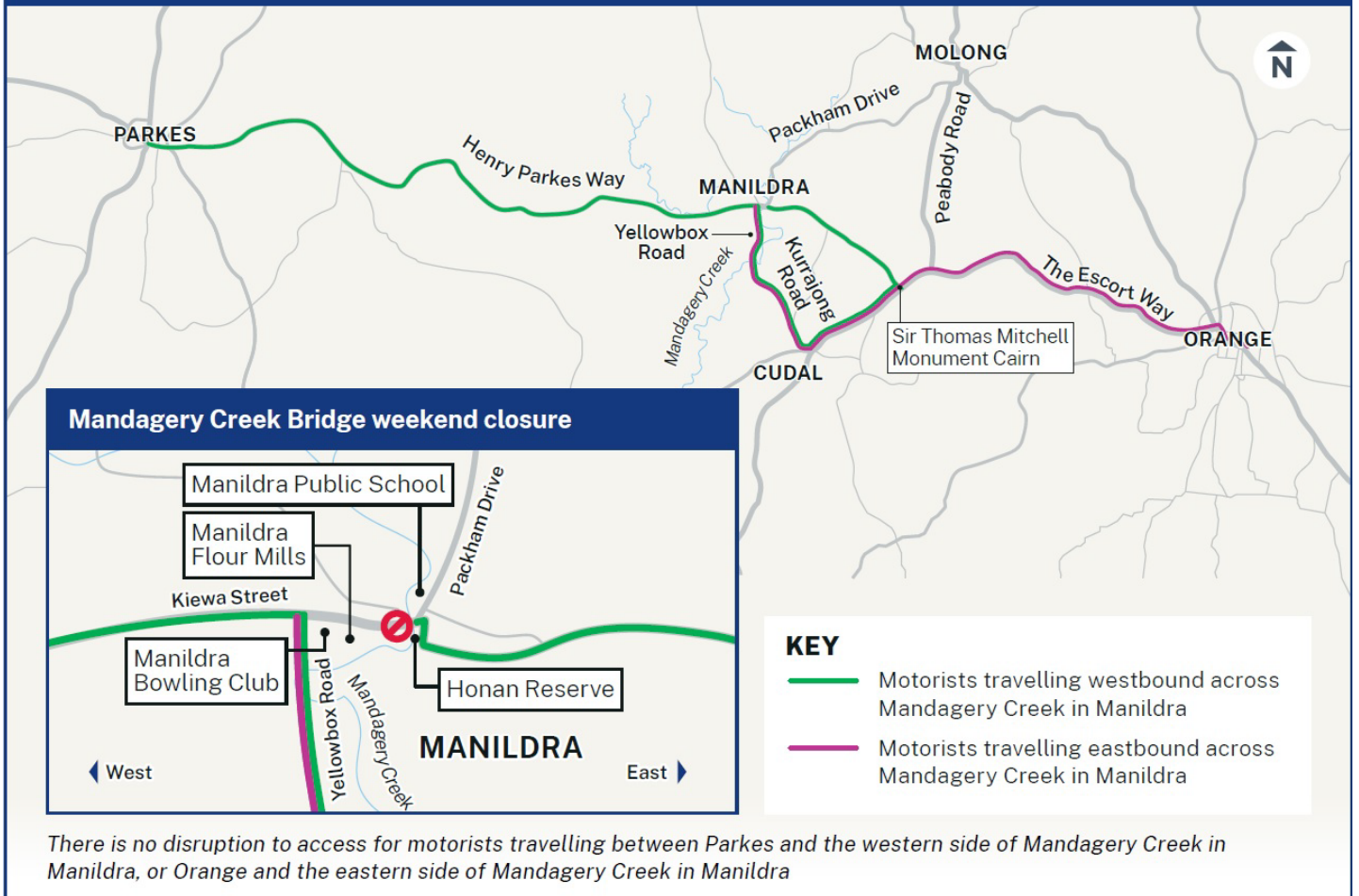
We have included a map to show the location of the closure and the detour described above.
