

# Upcoming inspection works at Manilla Viaduct

# Transport for NSW is prioritising public safety of heritage bridges along regional rail lines.

Transport for NSW (**Transport**) will conduct inspection works at Manilla Viaduct in November 2024 to maintain public safety.

#### What work are we doing?

To help manage and maintain safe, effective, and reliable access to the Manilla Viaduct, Transport will undertake an updated condition assessment of the viaduct. This important work will allow us to make informed decisions about the future management of the heritage structure.

The work will include:

- visual inspection using an elevated work platform (EWP)
- bore testing of timber elements
- all works will be carried in accordance with heritage listing requirements and relevant. approvals obtained prior to works taking place.

#### When and where we'll be working

We'll be carrying out the work from Monday, 25 November 2024 to Friday, 29 November 2024 across the full length of the viaduct from Namoi Street to Bowman Street.

Works will be conducted during standard working hours.

We have included a map of work area on the next page to show where the work will occur.

#### What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage for short periods while inspections of spans over roads are undertaken.

#### Managing our impacts

We are committed to minimising the impacts of our work activities on the community and the environment.

To manage our impacts, we will:

- minimise the use of traffic controllers only when spans over roads are being inspected
- only inspect spans within and adjacent to the showground on days where there are no events planned
- use appropriate tools to minimise impact to viaduct.

#### Next steps

Following the inspection results, our next steps will be to implement any further make safe works (if any) that are identified. Transport will inform the community of any additional works required.
