



Pedestrian walkway work along Railway Parade from 29 April

Medlow Bath Upgrade
April 2024



Transport for NSW pays respect to the Darug and Gundungurra peoples as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Medlow Bath Upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all road users, commuters, and pedestrians.

What work are we doing?

Construction is progressing on the new pedestrian bridge at Medlow Bath Station. Work is starting on the new walkway and kiss and ride area along Railway Parade and includes:

- removing trees within the rail corridor along a section of Railway Parade
- laying formwork for an accessible pedestrian walkway next to the station platform and security fencing
- constructing a new pedestrian walkway, to begin in May/June 2024.
- constructing a new kiss and ride area for commuter drop off/pick up at the top of Railway Parade. Work to continue on from pedestrian walkway.

This work will ensure that all everyone can move safely along Railway Parade, access the station, and safely drop off and pick up people at the top of Railway Parade.

When and where we'll be working

Work will begin on 29 April, and we expect it will be completed by late 2024, weather permitting.

Day work hours are from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 4pm on Saturdays.**

We have included a map over the page to show the location of work activities.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- an increase in project staff, plant and vehicle movements in the area
- work activity along Railway Parade and within the rail corridor
- signage and traffic impacts along Railway Parade.

Pedestrian access will be maintained along Railway Parade to Medlow Park, Potbelly Café and the station. Please follow signage and the marked path for your safety.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. This includes:

- minimising tree removal where possible
- planting new vegetation on site at completion of works
- managing vehicle movements along Railway Parade during the work
- providing a pedestrian access along Railway Parade
- turning off machinery when not in use
- liaising with directly affected stakeholders and always maintaining access to properties
- traffic control to maintain and direct vehicle movements.

Traffic Impacts

At times, traffic control will be in place including stop/slow operations and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h along Railway Parade.

Sections of the road will be closed when necessary to allow us to work safely, however, traffic access will always be maintained.
