

Work in Bellevue Crescent from 4 March

Medlow Bath Upgrade

February 2024



Transport for NSW pays respect to the Darug and Gundungurra people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Medlow Bath Upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all road users, commuters, and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW is continuing work on the Great Western Highway from south of Bellevue Crescent to Station Street, and on Railway Parade Upgrade.

What work are we doing?

Work is starting on the new roundabout in Bellevue Crescent and includes:

- Constructing a new roundabout at the Bellevue Crescent and Delmonte Avenue intersection
- Removing trees along a section of Bellevue Crescent and Delmonte Avenue so we can install stormwater drainage and relocate utilities
- Earthworks and pavement work
- Line marking.

When and where we'll be working

Work will start from 4 March, and we expect it will be complete by late 2024, weather permitting.

Day work hours are from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **Saturday from 8am to 4pm**.

Please note the extended Saturday working hours from **8am to 1pm to 8am to 4pm**.

We will mostly work during the day, however, we will do some night work for utility and stormwater.

Night work hours will be between **6pm and 7am, Monday to Friday** for no more than two nights in a row, and no more than three nights in a week.

Affected residents will be notified about any upcoming night work dates.

We have included a map over the page to show the location of our work activities.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment and additional noise mitigation measures have been provided to help reduce the impact of the work. This includes:

- Minimising tree removal where possible
- Maintaining access to properties at all times
- Maintaining pedestrian access along Bellevue Crescent and Delmonte Avenue
- Managing vehicle movements in Bellevue Crescent and Delmonte Avenue during the work
- Turning off machinery and vehicles not in use and arranging work in stages to minimise impacts to nearby residents
- Installing noise blankets around stationary equipment when possible
- Speaking with directly affected residents.

Traffic Impacts

Traffic control will be in place including stop/slow operations and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h along Bellevue Crescent and Delmonte Avenue. Sections of the road will be closed when necessary to allow us to work safely, however, traffic access will always be maintained.

Road users and pedestrians are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
