Medlow Bath Upgrade

The Medlow Bath Upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all road users, commuters, and pedestrians.

When and where we'll be working

Over the next **four weeks** we will be undertaking the following works:

Great Western Highway and Bellevue Crescent

- changing the Bellevue Crescent intersection, as outlined in the notification distributed 8
 October, all left and right entry and exits will be maintained.
- moving the westbound bus stop to its permanent location at the new pedestrian bridge
- general earthworks, pavement, drainage, utility and landscaping work
- constructing the shared path and driveways
- relocating barriers and linemarking to realign traffic.

Railway Parade

- utility work
- verge earthworks
- · constructing the sediment basin
- · landscaping.

Station Upgrade works

• constructing the pedestrian bridge, stairs, lifts and station services.

We will be working from 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and Saturday from 8am to 4pm.

Nightwork is expected to be carried out for the rest of the year with no more than six night shifts per month. These works are planned for the following dates, weather permitting:

November

- Monday 11 and Tuesday 12 these works will include changing the Belevue Crescent intersection and lifting the pedestrian bridge
- Thursday 21, Monday 25, Tuesday 26

December

- Monday 2, Wednesday 3 and Thursday 5
- Monday 16, Tuesday 17 and Thursday 19

Nightwork hours will be between **6pm and 7am**, **Monday to Friday**.

Affected residents will be notified closer to the date of work locations, activities and likely impacts.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community, residents and the environment.

This includes:

- maintaining pedestrian and property access
- turning off machinery and vehicles not in use and arranging work in stages
- installing noise blankets around stationary equipment when possible
- speaking with directly affected residents
- offering alternate accommodation for those who will experience significant impacts at night.
