

Changed access to Bellevue Crescent and United Petrol Station from 16 October

Medlow Bath Upgrade

Transport for NSW pays respect to the Darug and Gundungurra people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Medlow Bath Upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all road users, commuters, and pedestrians.

We are starting the construction on the intersection upgrade at Bellevue Crescent and the Great Western Highway.

As part of this, traffic will be moved onto the new eastbound lanes, east of Bellevue Crescent to facilitate construction of the westbound lanes of the Highway and the new intersection at Bellevue Crescent.

What work we are doing

Access into Bellevue Crescent and the United Service Station will move about 40 meters to the west of Bellevue Crescent.

All traffic movements will be maintained at this new intersection.

We will complete some of the earthworks, pavement, drainage and utility works during standard working hours.

Nightwork activities to facilitate this change will include:

- general earthworks, pavement, drainage and utility work
- relocating barriers
- linemarking.

When and where we'll be working

We will be completing nightwork on **16 and 17 October**. Nightwork hours will be between **6pm and 7am**.

Standard daywork hours apply for all other works.

The traffic changes for Bellevue Crescent and the United Service Station will be in place from **18 October** and remain until the **20 December**, weather permitting.

Managing our impacts

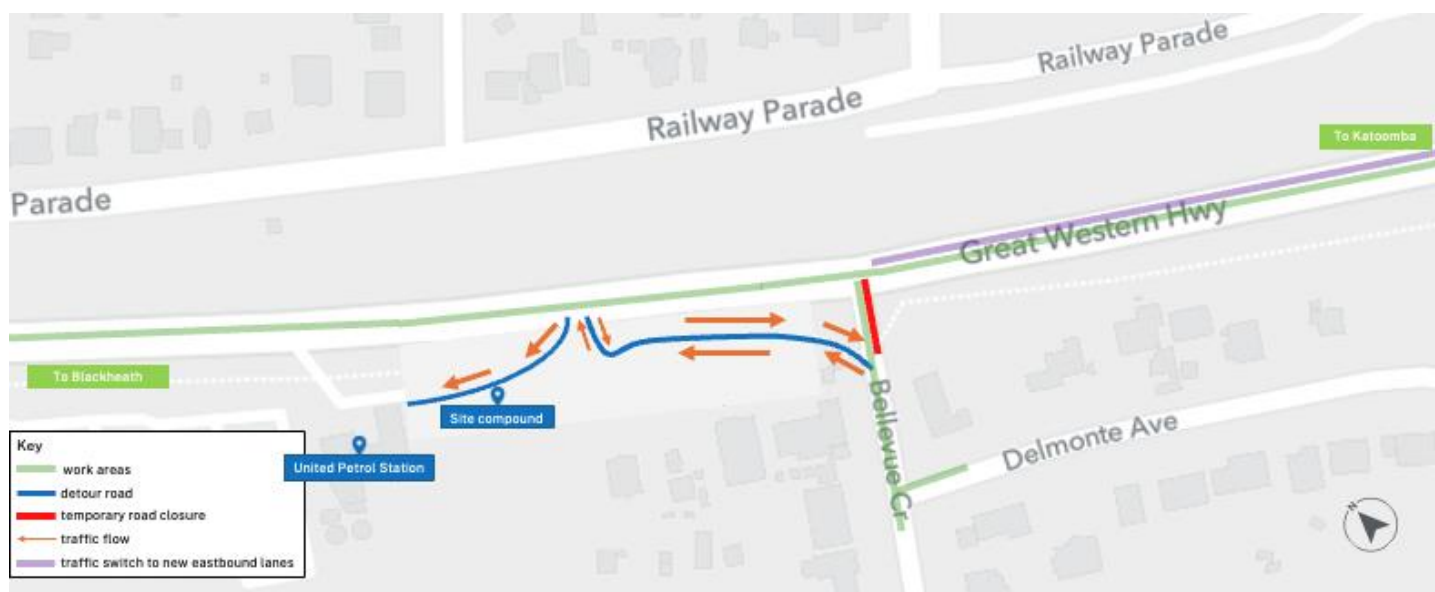
We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community, residents and the environment.

This includes:

- maintaining access to properties at all times
- maintaining pedestrian access
- turning off machinery and vehicles not in use and arranging work in stages
- installing noise blankets around stationary equipment when possible
- speaking with directly affected residents.

Traffic Impacts

Traffic control will be in place including stop/slow operations and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h or lower in some areas.

Traffic entering and exiting Bellevue Crescent and entering the United Petrol Station will use a temporary intersection, located about 40m west of the current Bellevue Crescent intersection.

All current vehicle movements will be maintained during this time.

Road users and pedestrians are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
