

Power outage for utility work on Monday October 28

Medlow Bath Upgrade

October 2024



Transport for NSW pays respect to the Darug and Gundungurra people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Medlow Bath Upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all road users, commuters, and pedestrians.

What work are we doing?

As part of the upgrade, Transport for NSW and its contractors will take advantage of a planned Endeavour Energy power outage to carry out utility work at the intersections of the Bellevue Crescent with the Great Western Highway and Delmonte Avenue.

We will be:

- relocating an existing power pole
- installing a new pole
- redirecting power cables.

When and where we'll be working

Endeavour Energy's planned power outage will take place on **Monday 28 October**.

We'll be working between **8am and 5pm** on **Monday 28 October**, weather permitting

We have included a map over the page to show the location of work activities.

What will this mean for you?

Residents directly impacted by the planned power outage on the 28 October will be notified by Endeavour Energy or their service provider.

How do Endeavour Energy manage planned outages?

Under the National Electricity Customer Framework (NECF), Endeavour Energy is required to provide customers with a minimum of four business days' prior notice of planned power outages to enable them to make alternative arrangements, if necessary.

If you are impacted by the power outage you should have already been advised of the date and time of the power outage via Endeavour Energy's standard outage notification process.

Residents and businesses are encouraged to make alternative arrangements if power is required during Endeavour Energy's planned power outage.

Customers who rely on a continuous power supply to operate medical equipment should plan ahead and contact their service provider to discuss their needs.

Managing our impacts

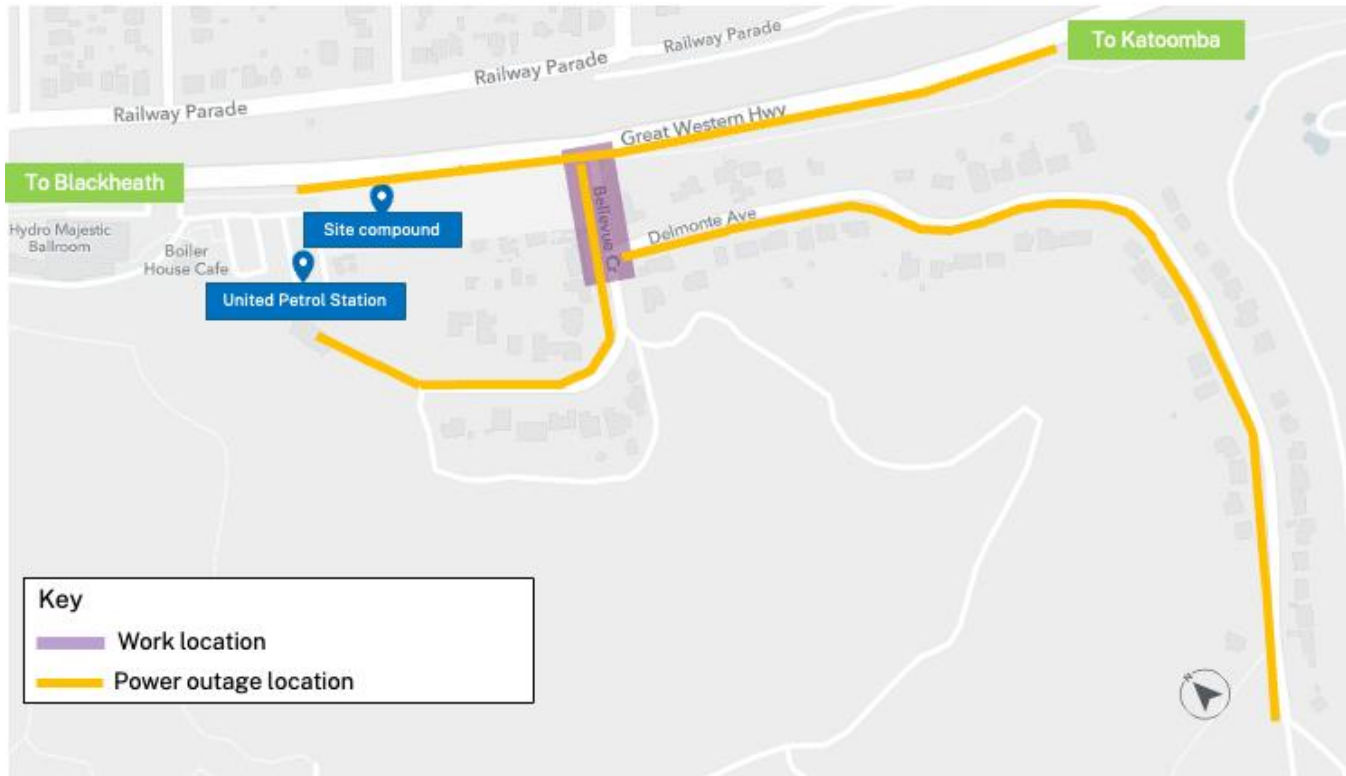
We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community, residents and the environment.

This includes:

- maintaining access to properties at all times
- maintaining pedestrian access
- turning off machinery and vehicles not in use and arranging work in stages
- installing noise blankets around stationary equipment when possible
- speaking with directly affected residents.

Traffic control will be in place including stop/slow operations and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h or lower in some areas.

Road users and pedestrians are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
