


Start of work for safety upgrades on the Mid Western Highway south of Blayney from Monday 25 November

Mid Western Highway - South Blayney Towards Zero Safer Roads Program

November 2024





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is investing in an important safety upgrade on a 2.5 kilometre section of the Mid Western Highway, approximately four kilometres south of Blayney.

This project is being delivered by the Towards Zero Safer Roads Program, a road safety infrastructure and speed management treatment program that aims to deliver sustainable and long-term reductions in road trauma through upgrades to the existing road network.

What work are we doing?

Installing a range of safety treatments including:

- · widening the centreline
- shoulder widening and clear zone improvements
- installation of roadside safety barriers
- extension of existing culverts
- removing some trees along the road corridor to allow for widening work.

When we'll be working

Work will commence from **Monday 25 November** and is expected to take approximately **nine months** to complete, weather permitting.

Work will be carried out between **6.30am and 6.00pm from Monday to Friday.**

Traffic impacts

For the safety of workers and motorists, a number of traffic changes will be in place:

- Single lane closures
- Reduced speed limit to 40 km/h
- · Intermittent stopping.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice noise from machinery and equipment as well as traffic control and signage.

Managing our Impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. This includes:

- reducing our noise as much as possible by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use
- maintaining access for residents and businesses during the work
- where possible, preserving native trees and protecting fauna.
