



Mortdale Maintenance Centre – Access Road Upgrade

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Bidjigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The More Trains, More Services program is designed to simplify and modernise the rail network, delivering a range of benefits for rail customers through better infrastructure, new trains and extra services.

Last year, we completed construction of a new bogie exchange system inside the Mortdale Maintenance Centre, enabling train wheels to be automatically removed from carriages and transported for maintenance.

Remaining work at Mortdale includes an upgrade of the access road off Oatley Avenue, east of the maintenance centre.

What work are we doing?

Work over the coming months involves access road widening, pavement upgrades, installation of a retaining wall and rail infrastructure improvements.

Work will be conducted predominately within the maintenance centre and adjoining car park.

In June 2024, we will be undertaking the following:

- establishment of temporary site compounds within the Oatley Seniors Citizen Centre car park and maintenance centre
- replacement of cabling infrastructure
- removal of a Eucalyptus tree in the Oatley Seniors Citizen Centre car park. Vegetation offset will be in accordance with Transport for NSW's Vegetation Offset Guide.

How can we re-purpose tree timber?

We are currently in conversations with local interest groups to determine if there is an opportunity to re-purpose the tree's timber. If you know of a group who may be able to re-use or re-purpose the tree, please let us know through the contact avenues listed on the page overleaf.

When and where we'll be working

Work will take place inside the maintenance centre and Oatley Seniors Citizen Centre car park, as shown in the map overleaf.

Standard construction hours are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.**

Out of hours work

In June, some work will be required to take place outside of standard construction hours between **6am and 6pm on Saturday 22 June and Sunday 23 June 2024.**

Why we work outside of standard construction hours

This work has been scheduled to take place outside of power isolation periods, minimising disruptions to commuter services and improving the safety of our construction team and customers.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- parking changes and traffic controllers
- deliveries of equipment and materials.
