# Moss Vale Station and Stabling Yard Upgrade

# **Community notification**

January 2025





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gundungurra and Tharawal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is delivering an upgrade to Moss Vale Station and Stabling Yard to make the station more accessible and to accommodate the new Regional Rail fleet.

The project will achieve Disability Standards for Accessible Public Transport 2002 (DSAPT) Compliance, providing a station precinct that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage, while ensuring it aligns with Moss Vale's transport needs.

## What work are we doing?

We will continue carrying out construction activities in and around the station and stabling yard, as well as on Argyle Street, Lackey Road and Dalys Way. Work will be scaled back over the Christmas period.

During this period we'll be:

- starting work from the Argyle Street footpath to the footbridge, requiring minor road changes and an alternate marked walkway
- removing temporary amenities at the station forecourt. Work will restart in January in the male and female toilets
- making minor temporary adjustments to parking and space within the forecourt
- continuing work on the stabling yard
- installing the Lackey Road lift and platform lift from mid-January. There will be no additional impacts with all work contained to the existing work areas.

### What does this mean for you?

Changes include:

- revising the location of the disability (DDA) parking in the commuter car park closest to the station
- reinstating some parking spaces in the station car park
- relocating pedestrian access to the Lackey Road side of Dalys Way, with a marked footpath and temporary safety barriers
- retaining one-way vehicle access on Daly's Way with manned traffic control and/or boom gates or traffic lights in place at the start of Dalys Way
- retaining access to the station waiting room through the rear doors
- starting work on the female waiting room and male toilet in early January. Temporary amenities will be installed for the duration of this work.

# When will we be working?

Work will be carried out during standard construction hours, **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturdays**.

All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.

This work will occur across all areas of the station and stabling yard. All construction areas will have fencing and signage for safety and security.

Tasks to be completed this month include:

- work at the base of the footbridge on Lackey Road
- work along Dalys way and the station forecourt
- work on Argyle Street and leading up to the Argyle Street footbridge entrance
- work on Platform 2 near the courtyard
- work opposite the commuter car park for the Mobile Train Simulator installation.



Dalys Way work began in November for improved pedestrian and road access.



The Lackey Road lift structure has been lifted into place alongside the existing footbridge.
