


Moss Vale Station and Stabling Yard Upgrade

Community notification

Work in October 2024





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is delivering an upgrade to Moss Vale Station and Stabling Yard to achieve Disability Standards for Accessible Public Transport 2002 (DSAPT) compliance and to accommodate the new Regional Rail fleet.

The project will provide a station precinct that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage, while ensuring it aligns with Moss Vale's transport needs.

What work are we doing?

Construction activities will continue this month in and around the station building and on Argyle Street, Lackey Road and Dalys Way.

Work includes:

- carrying out civil work within the station forecourt with archaeological supervision, including excavation, plumbing, kerb and gutters
- modifying commuter access and parking, including revised disability parking in the station forecourt (see figure on next page)
- continuing civil work on Argyle Street, including installing steel for new ramp
- installing lift glazing, brickwork and lift car in courtyard and Argyle Street
- upgrading family accessible toilet and entrance to ladies toilet
- carrying out civil, excavation and lift pit construction for the Lackey Road lift
- disconnecting existing light fittings and fixtures and partially removing track and

existing amenities at permanent stabling yard, which requires major civil and excavation work.

When will we be working?

Work will be carried out during standard construction hours, 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturdays.

What will this mean for you?

Access remains closed to pedestrians via Argyle Street.

Traffic control will continue to be in place along Lackey Road with minor changes to traffic conditions.

There will be multiple semi-trailers and road vehicles in the area.

Customers are asked to be aware that access to the station waiting room will be through the rear doors.

Alternate toilet facilities will be provided within the station forecourt. Please follow the signage provided.


The temporary stabling yard has opened for use. Noise blankets have been provided to mitigate the noise impact of this change.

Changes to station access

Access to the station will remain via Dalys Way or the footbridge on Lackey Road.

There will be a change to the access route and parking within the station forecourt as shown in the image on the next page.

Location of work area

Work will be spread out along Lackey Road and in and around the station building, adjacent to Argyle Street and on Dalys Way. Some work will continue within the area opposite the commuter car park for the Mobile Train Simulator.

All construction areas will have fencing and signage for safety and security.
