Mount Colah Station Footbridge Renewal

From Friday 8 March to Monday 11 March 2024

What we're doing

Sydney Trains is replacing the existing footbridge at Mount Colah Station. As part of the project, new lifts will also be constructed on the platform and eastern and western sides of the station.

Upcoming works

To prepare for the construction of a new pedestrian footbridge and lifts, the following major activities will occur in and around the station from **Friday 8 March to Monday 11 March**:

- Installation of precast bridge planks and associated temporary structures from Pierre Close and Pacific Highway
- Installation of the lift turret, canopy and link slab screens on the platform
- Installation of the stair balustrade
- Excavation work on station platform
- Installation of the overhead wire structure footing
- Removal of platform hoarding and installation of temporary fence.

Please note the existing footbridge will remain operational for pedestrian access and will have temporary lights.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works will create additional noise during the weekend.
- Works will take place from **9pm Friday 8 March to 12am Monday 11 March**.
- Power tools and machinery will be used throughout works; we will select low-noise equipment when available.
- Equipment and materials may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

Road and footpath closures

- Closure of the left (slow) lane on the Pacific Highway in the southbound direction will take place **from 10pm Friday 8 March to 9am on Saturday 9 March and again from 2pm Saturday 9 March to 12am Monday 11 March**.
- Pierre Close will be closed from Cowan Road from **9pm Friday 8 March to 12am Monday 11 March**. There will be no access/parking for vehicles at Pierre Close. Traffic control will be in place.
- From **12pm Friday 8 March to 12am Monday 11 March**, parking spots in Pierre Close from the cul-de-sac to 50 metres past the community centre driveway, will be unavailable to setup parking for the crane.

- Pedestrian detours will be setup around the cranes on both Pierre Close and Pacific Highway, please follow signage and traffic control. On Pacific Highway, pedestrians will detour around the crane via the closed traffic lane. On Pierre Close, pedestrians will detour around the crane via the Mount Colah Community Centre driveway.
- There will be a hold and release of traffic for trucks to reverse into Belmont Parade. Surrounding streets will have portable traffic control device in place to allow for oversize truck deliveries. Affected streets include: Berowra Road, Belmont Parade, Pacific Highway, Yirra Road, Jersey Street, Cowan Road and Colah Road.
- Motorists are encouraged to plan their trip and use alternate routes to avoid the area. Please use trip planner to plan your journey.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to direct motorists and pedestrians throughout the works.

Other Impacts

- Lights on the station platform and building will be switched off **from 12am Saturday 9 March to 12am Monday 11 March.**
- Bus stops on Pierre Close, Cowan Road, Colah Road and Pacific Highway will all remain operational throughout the work.
