
# Traffic changes and night work on Mulgoa Road between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road on 8, 9, 11, 14 and 15 October 2024

October 2024



Transport for NSW is continuing work on the Mulgoa Road upgrade between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road. **Night work** is scheduled on **8**, **9**, **11**, **14** and **15** October **2024**.

We will be working on Mulgoa Road, at the corner of side streets and the M4 Motorway ramps (see map on next page).

Working hours are 6pm to 7am on:

- Tuesday 8, Wednesday 9, Friday 11, Monday 14, and Tuesday 15 October 2024.
- In case of bad weather or operational issues, we will work on Thursday 10, and Wednesday 16 October 2024.

We will be using machinery such as temporary light towers, concrete saw, rollers, vibratory rollers, street sweeper, trench roller, jack hammer, hammer drill, plate compactors, concrete pump, tipper trucks, street sweeper, a concrete agitator, concrete vibrators, vacuum trucks, hand held rattle gun, excavators (including with breaker attachments), wheeled excavator, fixed track loader, electrical chainsaws, and other trucks for transporting material and saw cutting equipment.

# What work are we doing?

- Installing temporary street lighting on Mulgoa Road
- Utility and drainage investigations and

- installation on Mulgoa Road, side streets and M4 ramps
- Preparing to switch over to newly installed utility services along Mulgoa Road and side streets

**Australian Government** 

- Road maintenance work on Mulgoa Road,
  M4 ramps, and side streets
- Barrier installation and adjustment on Mulgoa Road and M4 ramps
- Pavement construction on Blaikie Road
- Backfilling the Wolseley Street tunnel
- Restoring the site when work is finished.

The stockpile site at 95 Blaikie Road will be used on all the above nights.

# What will this mean for you?

While our work may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including turning off machinery when not in use. We will try and complete the noisier part of the work before midnight. However, there may be some intermittent noisy work after midnight. You may hear some squawking from reversing trucks and flashing lights while we restore the worksite. These are essential for us to maintain safe work practices.

## Traffic changes day and night

As advised earlier, the exit out of Blaikie Road onto Mulgoa Road will be closed from **23 September to 21 October 2024**. Please use Blaikie Road and Jamison Road to access Mulgoa Road.


The eastbound off ramp from the M4 to Mulgoa Road will be closed at night on 14 and 15 October 2024 from 9pm to 5am. Road users are requested to use the Russell Street and The Northern Road ramps to access Mulgoa Road during ramp closures.

The M4 east bound ramp closures during the day on 10 and 11 October as advised

previously will not proceed. There will be lane and road closures during the night work along Mulgoa Road.

To ensure the safety of workers and motorists, there will be traffic controllers to guide road users. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
