Transport for NSW is continuing work on the Mulgoa Road upgrade between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road. **Night work** is scheduled on **1, 2, 5, 6 and 8 August 2024**.

We will be working on Mulgoa Road, at the corner of side streets and the M4 Motorway ramps (see map on next page).

Working hours are **6pm to 7am on:**

- **Thursday 1, Friday 2, Monday 5, Tuesday 6, and Thursday 8 August 2024.**
- In case of bad weather or operational issues, we will work on **Wednesday 7 and Friday 9, August 2024.**

We will be using machinery such as temporary light towers, concrete saw, rollers, street sweeper, excavator, plate compactors, tipper trucks, a concrete agitator, concrete vibrators, vacuum trucks, saw cutting equipment, excavators (including with breaker attachments) and other trucks for transporting material.

What work are we doing?

- Installing streetlights on Mulgoa Road between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road
- Installing utilities on Mulgoa Road, and side streets

- Removing a median along Mulgoa Road
- Temporary road surface work on Mulgoa Road, side streets and M4 ramps
- Preparing to adjust traffic lights on Mulgoa Road
- Drainage work on Mulgoa Road, side streets and M4 ramps
- Preparing to switch over to newly installed utility services along Mulgoa Road and side streets
- Adjusting barriers on Mulgoa Road and the M4 ramps.
- Restoring the site when work is finished.

The stockpile site at 95 Blaikie Road will be used on all the above nights.

What will this mean for you?

While our work may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including turning off machinery when not in use.

We will try and complete the noisier part of the work before midnight. However, there may be some intermittent noisy work after midnight. You may hear some squawking from reversing trucks and flashing lights while we restore the worksite. These are essential for us to maintain safe work practices.

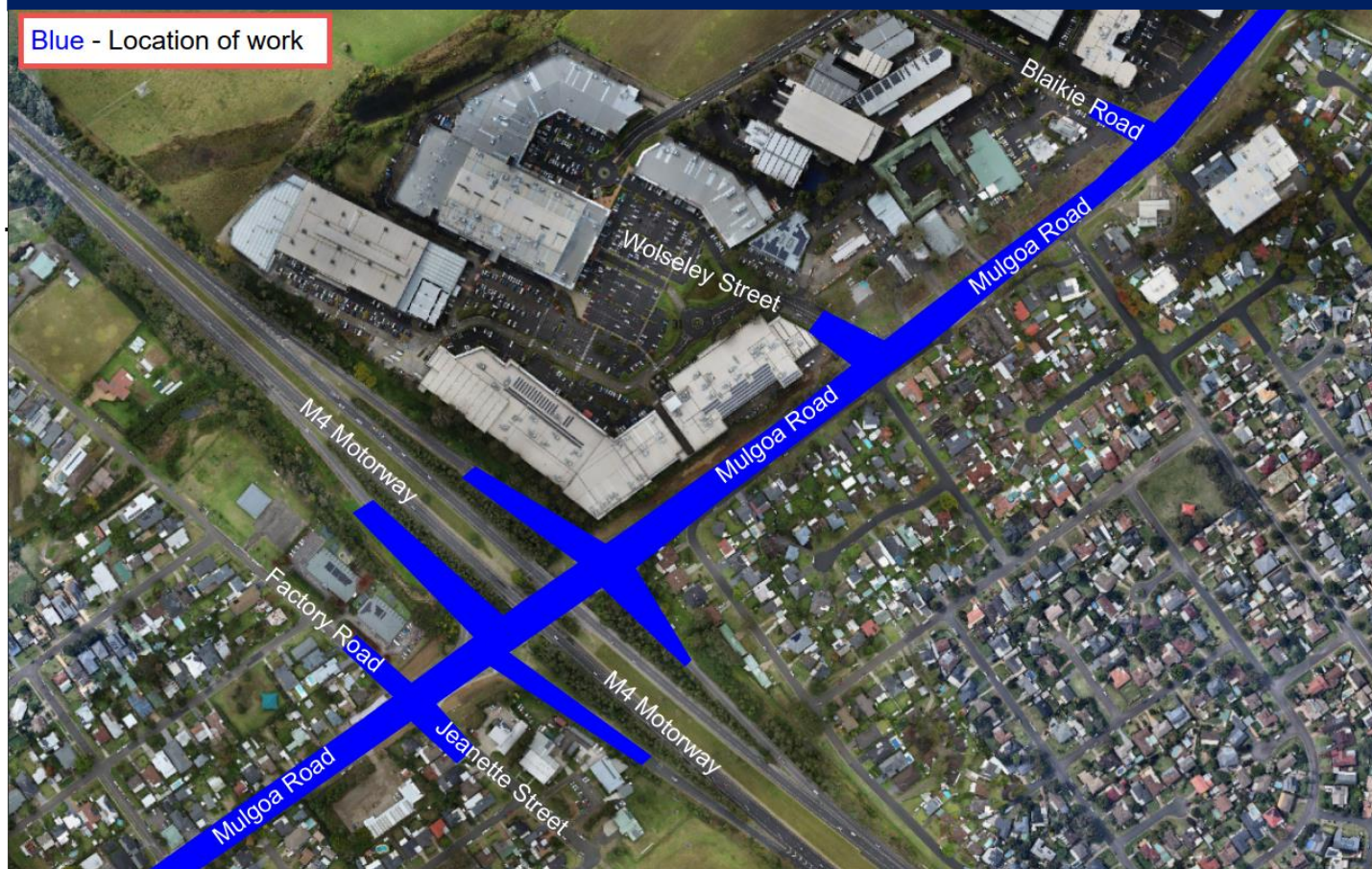
Traffic changes
