


# Night work on Mulgoa Road between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road on 2, 3, 5, 9 and 10 September 2024

August 2024

Transport for NSW is continuing work on the Mulgoa Road upgrade between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road. **Night work** is scheduled on **2**, **3**, **5**, **9** and **10 September 2024.** 

We will be working on Mulgoa Road, at the corner of side streets and the M4 Motorway ramps (see map on next page). Working hours are **6pm to 7am on:** 

- Monday 2, Tuesday 3, Thursday 5,
  Monday 9, and Tuesday 10 September 2024.
- In case of bad weather or operational issues, we will work on Wednesday 4,
   Friday 6, and Wednesday 11
   September 2024.

We will be using machinery such as temporary light towers, concrete saw, rollers, street sweeper, excavator, plate compactors, tipper trucks, a concrete agitator, concrete vibrators, vacuum trucks, excavators (including with breaker attachments) and other trucks for transporting material and saw cutting equipment.

# What work are we doing?

 Installing utilities on Mulgoa Road, M4 ramps, and side streets

- Temporary road surface work on Mulgoa Road, side streets and M4 ramps
- Preparing to switch over to newly installed utility services along Mulgoa Road and side streets
- Preparing to adjust traffic lights on Mulgoa Road
- Line marking on Mulgoa Road and side streets
- Installing temporary street lighting on Mulgoa Road
- Restoring the site when work is finished.

The stockpile site at 95 Blaikie Road will be used on all the above nights.

# What will this mean for you?

While our work may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including turning off machinery when not in use. We will try and complete the noisier part of the work before midnight. However, there may be some intermittent noisy work after midnight. You may hear some squawking from reversing trucks and flashing lights while we restore the worksite. These are essential for us to maintain safe work practices.

# Traffic changes

There will be lane and road closures during the night work along Mulgoa Road.

On September 11, there will be traffic changes in place and a notification about these changes will be distributed prior to this date. To ensure the safety of workers and motorists, there will be traffic controllers to guide road user.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
