Transport for NSW is continuing work on the Mulgoa Road upgrade between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road. **Night work** is scheduled on **24 and 25 June, and 1 and 2 July 2024.**

What work are we doing?

Work includes:

- Utility installation, investigations and switching over of utilities
- Drainage investigation
- Preparation works for traffic switch including demolition of median
- Restoring the site when work is finished.

We will be working on Mulgoa Road, at the corner of side streets and the M4 Motorway ramps (see map overleaf).

Working hours are **6pm to 7am on:**

- **Monday 24, and Tuesday 25 June, and Monday 1 July and Tuesday 2 July 2024.**
- In case of bad weather or operational issues, work may be postponed to **Wednesday 26, Thursday 27 and Friday 28 June, and 3 July 2024.**

We will be using machinery such as temporary light towers, plate compactors, tipper trucks, a concrete agitator, concrete vibrators, vacuum trucks, excavators (including with breaker attachments) and

other trucks for transporting material and saw cutting equipment.

Our schedule of work

- Utility installation, investigations and switching over on Mulgoa Road and side streets
- Drainage works on Mulgoa Road, Wolseley Street, and the M4 ramps
- Median demolition and barrier adjustments on Mulgoa Road and the M4 ramps.

The stockpile site at 95 Blaikie Road will be used on all the above nights.

What will this mean for you?

While our work may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including turning off machinery when not in use.

We will try and complete the noisier part of the work before midnight. However, there may be some intermittent noisy work after midnight. You may hear some squawkers from reversing trucks and flashing lights while we restore the worksite. These are essential for us to maintain safe work practices.

Traffic changes

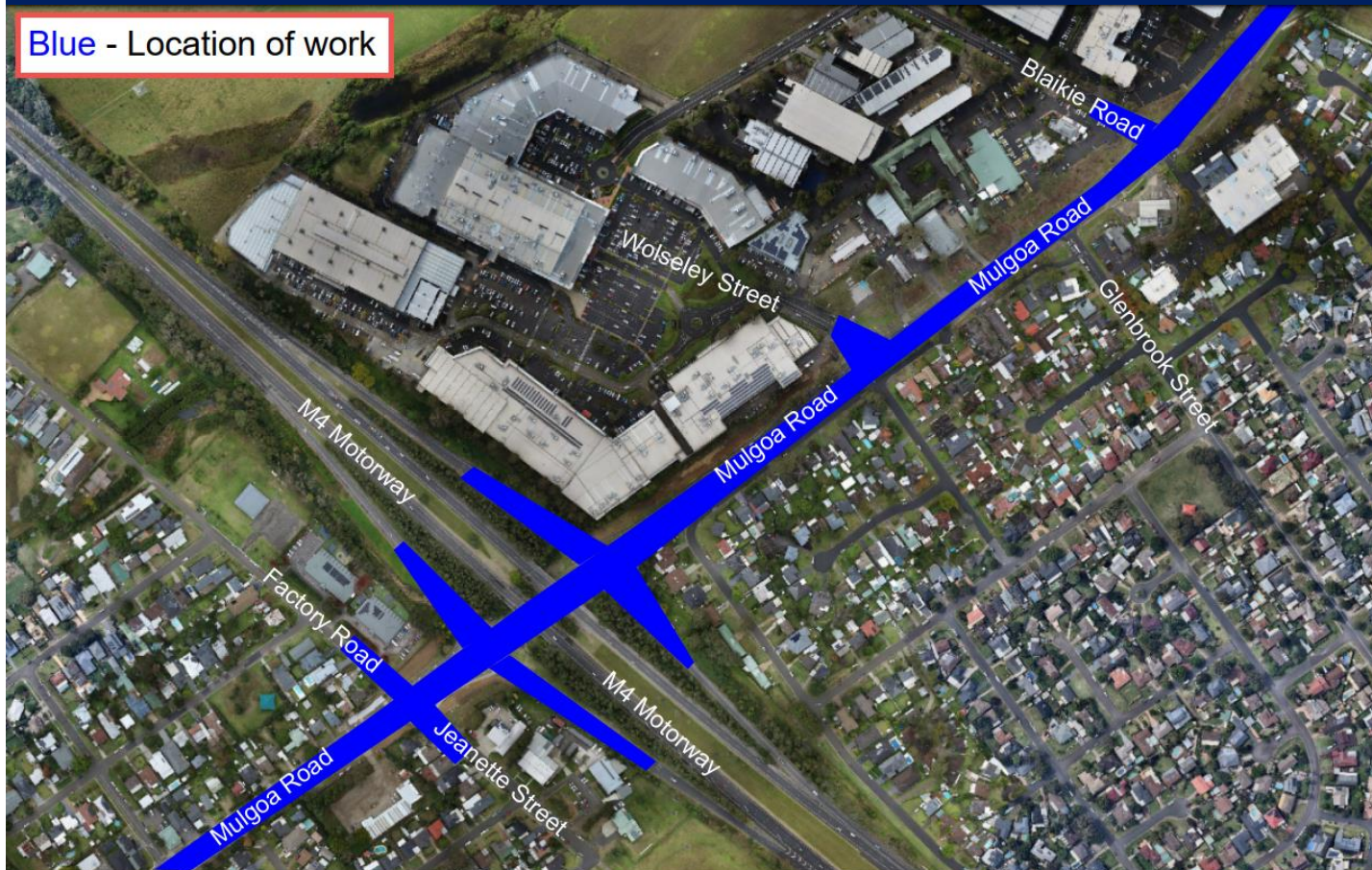
There will be lane closures during the night work along Mulgoa Road. To ensure the safety of workers and motorists, there will be traffic controllers to guide drivers.
