
Night work on 18, 19, 25 and 27 November 2024, M4 ramps to Mulgoa Road and lanes on Mulgoa Road closed – 5am Monday to 5am Wednesday 18-20 November

Transport for NSW is continuing work on the Mulgoa Road upgrade between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road.

The M4 eastbound and westbound ramps to Mulgoa Road, and one lane each way on Mulgoa Road is planned to be closed on 18-20 November 2024.

What and when are we doing the work?

We will be working to remove the tunnel at Wolseley Street and Mulgoa Road, (see map on next page).

To do this efficiently we will be working on the following dates and times:

- 5am Mon 18 Nov to 5am Wed 20 Nov
- 5am Tue 3 Dec to 5am Thu 5 Dec (contingency date)

We will also be undertaking the following work along Mulgoa Road, side streets and M4 ramps from 6pm to 7am on, Monday 18, Tuesday 19, Monday 25, and Wednesday 27 November 2024:

- Drainage and utility investigations and installations
- Road maintenance work
- Road surface work.

The stockpile site at 95 Blaikie Road will be used on all the above nights.

In case of bad weather or operational issues, we will work on Wednesday 20, Thursday 21, Friday 22, and Tuesday 26 November 2024.

We will be using machinery such as temporary light towers, concrete saws, excavators, trucks, and other equipment that may be needed.

Traffic changes day and night

We will be making the following traffic changes from 5am on Monday to 5am on Wednesday:

- The eastbound and westbound off ramps from the M4 to Mulgoa Road will be closed for the full two days listed. Road users on the M4 are requested to use the Russell Street and The Northern Road ramps to access Mulgoa Road during ramp closures
- All M4 on ramps at Mulgoa Road will remain open during the 48-hour closures
- One lane will be closed in each direction on Mulgoa Road
- The Wolseley Street access to the Penrith Homemaker Centre will remain open at all times but will be reduced to one lane in and one lane out during the work. Access will also be available via Pattys Place and Blaikie Road
- The pedestrian crossing at Wolseley Street is closed and the crossing at Glenbrook Street is open.

There will be lane and road closures during the night work along Mulgoa Road.

What will this mean for you?

Access to Mulgoa Road from the M4 will be restricted and road users may face delays on Mulgoa Road and on Wolseley Street.


While our work may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including turning off machinery when not in use.

We will try and complete the noisier part of the work before midnight, However, there may be some intermittent noisy work after midnight. You may hear some squawking from reversing trucks and flashing lights while we restore the worksite.

These are essential for us to maintain safe work practices.

To ensure the safety of workers and motorists, there will be traffic controllers to guide road users. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
