Koolewong, Tascott, Point Clare and Tuggerah Stations

July and August 2024

We are delivering new, state-of-the-art intercity and regional trains.

The new trains will provide new safety features, improved accessibility, facilities and reliability for passengers who travel on our regional and intercity networks.

To accommodate the new Regional Rail and Mariyung fleets, we need to upgrade and modify some existing rail infrastructure at various locations across the rail network.

What work are we doing?

In July and August, work within the rail corridor includes:

- survey investigations for future signalling infrastructure
- installing trackside posts
- relocating car markers
- installing car markers
- signalling installation works

Equipment and machinery to be used:

- laser scanning and survey equipment
- vacuum truck
- hand tools including bars, shovels, jackhammer, concrete mixing tools
- electrical testing equipment.

When and where we'll be working

From Monday 22 July, we will be working at or around **Koolewong, Tascott, Point Clare and Tuggerah** Stations during standard construction hours of **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

Out of hours work

To minimise disruption to the rail network and for the safety of staff and customers, some work is required to take place outside of standard construction hours, during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork.

We will be working from **6am to 6pm on Saturday 27 July and Sunday 28 July**, and **Saturday 3 August and Sunday 4 August 2024** to carry out the activities listed above.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- noise from construction activities.

Managing our impacts

We will take steps to reduce noise and impacts on the community and the environment.

This includes and is not limited to:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers
- instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum, where possible.
