The NSW and Australian Governments are jointly funding the \$261.17 million Heavy Duty Pavement Upgrade of the Newell Highway between Narrabri and Moree under the Newell Highway Upgrade program.

What work are we doing?

Work will include pavement work at the approaches to Halls Creek bridge on the Newell Highway.

When and where we'll be working

Work will be carried out at the approaches to Halls Creek bridge about six kilometres south of Moree from **7am to 6pm** from **Wednesday 21 August**. Work is expected to be completed in **four days** weather permitting.

We have included a map below to show the location of the work.

Traffic changes

Work on the Newell Highway will be carried out under existing traffic control conditions to keep the work zone safe, which includes reduced speed limits, lane closures and intermittent stopping.

Ongoing delays of at least 15 minutes should be expected when travelling between Narrabri and Moree. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. Oversize Overmass (OSOM) changes

OSOM vehicles over **six metres wide** may be subject to delays of up to **60 minutes** while this work is being carried out.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- reducing our noise as much as possible
- turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use
- installing variable messaging signs (VMS) to assist in directing traffic
- maintaining property access for residents at all times.
