



New Lake Entrance Road and Pioneer Drive additional left turn lane

Review of Environmental Factors

August 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is proposing to build an additional left turn lane from New Lake Entrance Road onto Pioneer Drive.

An additional left turn lane on the southern approach to the roundabout is needed to relieve congestion and reduce delays and queue lengths through the intersection from the Oak Flats interchange.

As part of our planning process, a Review of Environmental Factors (REF) has been prepared and is now on public display for feedback until **Friday 6 September 2024**.

Key features of the proposal

- Additional left turn lane providing extra queuing capacity for traffic turning left into Pioneer Drive from New Lake Entrance Road
- Dedicated cycle lane connecting the interchange with Pioneer Drive
- A rock-filled retaining wall along the northern side of New Lake Entrance Road.

An REF assesses the potential environmental, social and economic impacts of the proposal and recommends measures to reduce these impacts.

These include:



Vegetation removal and changes to the surrounding landscape



Impacts during construction such as noise and traffic changes



Impacts to pedestrian and shared paths and cycle lanes


