Continuing early work for The Driftway upgrade until Friday 1 March 2024

The Australian and NSW Governments have committed \$500 million for the New Richmond Bridge and traffic improvements project, that includes a new bridge over the Hawkesbury River between Richmond and North Richmond.

The project is divided into two stages to deliver early safety benefits to the community. Stage 1 includes upgrades to The Driftway between Londonderry and Blacktown roads. The remainder of the project will be delivered in Stage 2.

What work are we doing?

As part of our early work for Stage 1, we have completed building and relocating additional Sydney Water mains at various locations along The Driftway between Blacktown Road and Londonderry Road. We are continuing site investigation activities as part of the detailed design development.

Our site investigation activities will continue until Friday 1 March 2024. These activities include:

- Underground utility investigation
- Potholing
- Restoring and cleaning up work areas when finished.

When and where we'll be working

We will be working along The Driftway between Blacktown Road and Londonderry Road.

Daytime work is between 7am and 6pm on weekdays and between 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.

If any night work is needed, we will notify you seven days before this work starts. Night work hours would be between 8pm and 7am from Sunday to Thursday. No work will be carried out during public holidays.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times. However, we will implement noise control measures to minimise the impact. This includes staging the work along different parts of the work zone to minimise disruption in the same area.

If work is required on your property, a Transport representative will contact you in advance to discuss work involved including property access. We typically will not need to enter your house and you do not need to be at home when the work happens, but we will discuss any requirements with you.

Acoustic Treatments

We are continuing to work with property owners on noise mitigation for their properties. Noise mitigation work is required when predicted traffic modelling suggests future noise at the property will exceed acceptable levels.

Details about noise modelling for Stage 1 is included in the project's Review of Environmental Factors (REF) that is available on our project webpage transport.nsw.gov.au/the-driftway.

Traffic changes

While we will try minimising disruption to traffic, temporary traffic changes will be required at times to ensure the work zone is safe and reduced speed limits may be in place.

Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
