The NSW Government is funding maintenance work on Old Karuah Bridge, over Karuah River at Karuah, to preserve the structural integrity and reduce future maintenance costs.

What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW will carry out the work, which includes site establishment and concrete repair and protection.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working from **Monday 3 June for up to 12 months**, weather permitting.

Working hours are **6am to 5pm, from Monday to Friday**, tide and weather permitting. No work will be carried out on public holidays for the duration of the project.

For the safety of the workers, a large component of this work is being completed during low tides.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside of these times.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- On occasion, single lane closures with a 40km/h speed limit will be in place
- Some channel closures
- Noise from machinery and equipment.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Managing our impacts

Work will be carried out from under the bridge.

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

We will minimise impact by:

- Reducing our noise as much as possible
- Turning off machinery when not in use.
