Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The Australian and NSW governments are building the M12 Motorway to provide direct access to the Western Sydney International Airport at Badgerys Creek and connect to Sydney's motorway network.

What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW will work over **21 nights** between **Thursday 1 February** and **Thursday 29 February 2024** along Elizabeth Drive, west of Badgerys Creek Road in Badgerys Creek, The Northern Road and Luddenham Road, Luddenham.

During this period, we will:

- repair, maintain, install, remove and adjust road pavement, barriers, line marking, signage and road furniture as required
- complete utilities work across Elizabeth Drive under traffic control conditions
- deliver materials to the construction site on The Northern Road, Elizabeth Drive and Luddenham Road
- install retaining wall panels next to Elizabeth Drive
- continue Elizabeth Drive bridge works including delivery and lifting of materials such as steel and pour concrete
- deliver material for the concrete batch plant
- undertake concrete paving work
- deliver, use and remove oversized equipment when needed, including delivery and unloading of large concrete beams.

We will work at night for the safety of our workers and road users, and to minimise traffic disruption.

We will also continue bridge work across either side of Elizabeth Drive, Badgerys Creek during the day. Traffic control will be in place to manage traffic across the construction intersection on Luddenham Road.

When and where we'll be working

Our night work hours are between **6pm** and **7am**, **Monday to Saturday morning**. Our normal work hours are between **7am** and **6pm**, **Monday to Friday** and between **7am** and **6pm** on **Saturdays**. There will be no work on public holidays.

What equipment will be used?

During the night work we may use lighting towers, excavators, skid steers, trucks, compactors, light and heavy vehicles, hand powered tools, road saw, large crawler crane, small cranes and wheeled excavators, vacuum trucks, concrete pumps, water carts, sweepers, milling machines, asphalt pavers, water blasters for line marking removal, and line marking trucks. When we work at night and on the road we will have traffic control in place.

What will this mean for you?

During night work, you may see increased activities in the area. Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing noisier activities earlier in the night before **midnight**, where possible, and turning off equipment and machinery when not in use.

We will not perform high noise work activities more than two nights in a row and three nights in the same week at the same location.



Managing our impacts

There will be temporary traffic changes along the work zone during our work hours to ensure the work zone

and traffic are safe while the equipment is used, delivered and removed.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
