



# Night work at Pacific Highway - Oxley Highway Interchange from Sunday 10 November

## Safety improvement work

November 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Birpai people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is investing in the Pacific Highway – Oxley Highway Interchange, to improve safety and reduce queuing on the northbound exit ramp.

### What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW will carry out work, using the existing road formation to provide a cost-effective option that will increase the capacity of the ramp from one to two lanes between the 60 km/hr sign to the donut.

Work will include:

- vegetation clearing
- removal of adjacent concrete and kerb
- minor asphalt work
- resealing and line marking
- signage installation.

### When we'll be working

Work will be carried out in two phases. Phase one will be a few nights work to prepare the site. Phase two will be the remainder of the work to deliver two lanes on the ramp.

To carry out phase one, we will be working at night from **Sunday 10 November to Thursday 14 November** between **8pm and 5am**, weather permitting.

We expect to be back on site for phase two, working at night from **Sunday 24 November to Friday 6 December** between **8pm and 5am**, weather permitting.

### What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signage
- lane closures and reduced speed limits
- some noise periodically from machinery and equipment.

### Traffic impacts

The northbound exit ramp will be closed for both phases to allow for the work to take place. A detour will be in place for motorists travelling northbound who wish to exit from the Pacific Highway onto the Oxley Highway. Motorists are advised to use the Sancrox Road exit from the Pacific Highway. Motorists should allow **up to 10 minutes extra** travel time during this work.

Northbound lane closure on the Pacific Highway, traffic control, electronic message boards and reduced speed limits will be in place during the work for the safety of workers and motorists.

### Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to minimise impacts by:

- reducing our noise as much as possible
- turning off machinery when not in use.
