

What work are we doing?

Geotechnical investigations will be carried out in the car parks near Wyong station.

Traffic controllers will help safely direct motorists, pedestrians and workers through the site.

When and where we'll be working

Work will be carried out in car parks at the train station, including the commuter car parks on the eastern and western side of Wyong Station, the Railway Square car park and the Rose Street community car park.

We'll be working from **Monday 4 December to Friday 22 December**, weather permitting.

Working hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturday. Some night work may be carried out between 7pm to 5am, Sunday to Thursday.

What will this mean for you?

We expect a maximum of eight parking spots to be impacted each day while work is carried out. The car parks will remain open during the work, with a minor reduction in the number of available spaces. Additional parking is available at the community car park which is accessible from Rose Street.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. Noise barriers will be used to avoid disturbance.
