


Parramatta Road - New traffic light crossing at M4 westbound on-ramp, Homebush

The Parramatta Road Urban Amenity Improvement Program (Program) is an initiative by the NSW Government to improve open spaces and active transport links along the Parramatta Road corridor.

The Program brings state agencies and local councils together to collaborate on projects that improve public amenity on the Parramatta Road corridor. Transport for NSW (Transport) continues to deliver improvements including a continuous walking and cycling route.

What work are we doing?

Transport will continue delivery of a new staggered traffic light crossing for pedestrians and cyclists at the Homebush intersection of Parramatta Road and the M4 westbound on-ramp. We have now completed laying of conduits and installation of new traffic light post footings on the westbound side.

Due to school holidays and high volumes of traffic, we need to return to site to complete the work. This will include:

- a staggered signalised pedestrian crossing
- new median fencing
- new kerb ramps on both sides of Parramatta Road
- new line marking.

When we'll be working

Work is expected to be completed by **Friday 31 May 2024**, weather permitting. We will be on site for up to 14 shifts, for no more than 5 shifts per week.

Our work hours will be between **8pm to 5am**, Sunday to Thursday. We will not work on Friday and Saturday nights or public holidays.

What will this mean for you?

Our work may be noisy at times, and we appreciate this can be inconvenient. We will do everything we can to minimise impact including using noise curtains and completing noisier tasks before midnight. You may notice:

- · workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signage
- lane closures and reduced speed limits
- footpath closures
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes including single lane closures and a work zone speed limit of 40 km/h will be in place to maintain safety for workers and road users.

Traffic flow and access to properties will be maintained at all times. Traffic controllers will be on site to guide pedestrians, cyclists and traffic. Please use caution, keep to speed limits and follow directions.



There will be changed traffic conditions at this intersection, once the traffic signals are active.
