



Pennant Hills Road and North Rocks Road, Carlingford

Start of early works

July 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Burramattagal people of the Dharug Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is upgrading the intersection of Pennant Hills Road and North Rocks Road to ease congestion, reduce travel times and improve safety for road users.

Early works will commence on **Sunday 4 August 2024**.

A further community update will be provided in September 2024.

What work are we doing?

August early works will include:

- installation of two site compounds including site sheds and fencing
- locating existing underground services
- vegetation trimming and removal
- pre-construction land and property surveys
- waste classification sampling and management
- installation of four project signs.

When will we be working?

August early works will take place between **Sunday 4 and Thursday 29 August 2024**:

- standard work hours will be **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm, Saturday**.
- out-of-hours work will be required for **five nights each week** from **Sunday to Friday** between **8pm and 5am** the next day.

Establishment of site compounds

Two site compounds will be established at the Pennant Hills and North Rocks Road intersection:

- one on the northeast corner
- one on the southwest corner, where a Transport-owned building will be demolished, and asbestos removed. The removal will be monitored by a licensed specialist.

How will the work affect you?

While we complete this work, you may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- noise and vibration from machinery
- temporary changes to traffic, cycling and pedestrian access, including lane closures

Traffic controllers will be on site to assist motorists, residents and pedestrians as required.

Managing our impacts

We aim to limit impacts to the community by:

- Fencing for safety and security
- Using quieter equipment where practicable and turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Completing noisier work earlier in the evening
- Using targeted lighting to reduce light spill at night.

During work, in the event of an unexpected asbestos or other contaminated material find, the area will be isolated until the material can be safely removed by qualified professionals.
