


Pennant Hills Road and North Rocks Road upgrade, Carlingford

Start of construction

August 2024





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Burramattagal people of the Dharug Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading the intersection of Pennant Hills Road and North Rocks Road, Carlingford to ease congestion, reduce travel times and improve safety for road users.

The project is being delivered as part of the NSW Government's \$450 million Urban Roads Congestion Program, which aims to reduce congestion and improve travel times on Sydney's busiest corridors.

Early works commenced on Sunday 4 August, with start of construction to begin on **Friday 30 August.**

What work have we done so far?

As part of early works we have:

- established a temporary site compound
- installed project signage
- commenced preparation of the two permanent site compounds
- commenced investigation works to locate existing underground services
- commenced waste classification sampling and management
- completed preconstruction land surveys and commenced property surveys.

What work will we be doing?

Between 30 August and 30 November 2024 we will:

- complete permanent site compound establishment
- continue investigation works on existing underground services locations
- complete waste classification sampling and management
- continue to carry out property surveys.

Construction work activities will include:

- tree removal and vegetation clearing
- demolition and road realignment work within the road corridors
- traffic signal and utility adjustment work
- property adjustment works.

Establishment of site compounds

Establishment of the site compound on the southwest corner of the intersection will include:

- demolition of an existing building
- asbestos removal.

Asbestos removal

Transport for NSW works with qualified asbestos professionals, such as licensed asbestos removalists and Licensed Asbestos Assessors, to safely manage and remove asbestos from project sites and dispose of any asbestos waste to a licensed waste facility.

If, during construction, asbestos not previously identified is found, work will immediately stop while asbestos materials are further assessed and safely removed.

When will we be working?

Between **30 August** and **30 November 2024** work will be carried out between our standard working hours of **Monday** and **Friday**, **7am** to **6pm** and **Saturday**, **8am** to **1pm**.

Out of hours work

Between 30 August and 30 November 2024 additional out of hours work will also be required for up to five nights each week, between Sunday and Thursday 8pm and 5am the next day.

We will not work on weekends between Saturdays, 1pm and Sundays, 8pm. We will not work on the upcoming public holiday Monday 7 October 2024.

How will the work affect you?

While we carry out our work you may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- noise and vibration from machinery
- temporary traffic changes, including lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/hr
- temporary pedestrians and cyclist detours around the work zone.

Access to pedestrian crossings will be maintained at all times.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Managing our impacts


We aim to minimise community impacts by:

- fencing our work site for safety and security
- using quieter equipment where possible
- turning off equipment when not in use
- completing noisier activities like mulching, sawcutting and jackhammering by midnight
- directing construction lighting to avoid excess glare or light into neighbouring properties.
